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BI-ANNUAL REPORT ON THE ANALYSIS OF TARIFF NOTIFICATIONS SUBMITTED TO ICASA FOR THE PERIOD 01 JULY 2021 TO 31 DECEMBER 2021

Executive Summary

The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("ICASA / the Authority") is mandated to regulate electronic communications in the public interest. In ensuring that it carries this mandate effectively, it monitors the Information Communications and Technology ("ICT") sector to ensure that interests of the consumers are promoted as per object 2(n) of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005, as amended (Act No. 36 of 2005) ("ECA"). This tariff analysis report aims to ensure that end-users (customers) are aware of the various prepaid retail tariffs in the telecommunications sector which were filed with the Authority during the period of 01 July 2021 to 31 December 2021¹, as well as provide an update on initiatives which are currently underway to reduce the cost to communicate. This ensures that there is retail tariff transparency, which could potentially encourage competition as it is likely to minimise pricing and product information asymmetries in the sector.

Table 1 shows the types of notifications received in the period 01 July 2021 to 31 December 2021.

The Authority received a total of 270 tariff notifications, which included 73 new promotions, 105 amendments, 26 extensions, 65 new products and 1 termination during the period under review, i.e., 01 July 2021 to 31 December 2021.

¹ There are instances whereby information reported in this report falls outside of this review period. These are where the additional information is to the benefit of customers such as extensions of promotions and/or reduced data prices for standard 30-day or any other prepaid data bundles offered by various licensees which were possibly filed outside of the review period or whereby the intention is to ensure accurate reporting and to reduce information asymmetries, which is one of the main purposes of the report. The inclusion of such information also considers feedback received during the licensee consultation phase of the production of this Report.

In the mobile data services market, salient changes in the period under review were the amendments of the 30-day standard prepaid data bundles by all four major operators. MTN reduced the prices of its 200MB, 350MB, 500MB, 1GB, 1.5GB, 2GB, 3GB, 6GB, 20GB, 50GB and 100GB data bundles. For example, the 1GB data realised a 14.1% price reduction from R 99 to R 85. Telkom Mobile's amendment entailed the price reduction of the 1GB data bundle by 20.2%, from R 99 to R 79 and the introduction of the 1.5GB data bundle at a price of R 89. Vodacom reduced the price of its 2GB, 50GB and 100GB from R 159, R 1 499 and R 2 399 to R 149, R 799 and R 999, respectively. Vodacom also introduced the 4GB, 6GB and 15GB data bundles in its 30-day standard prepaid data bundle plan. Cell C's amendment entailed the replacement of the 80MB, 150MB, 325MB and 800MB data bundles with the 100MB, 200MB, 350MB, 500MB, respectively. Cell C also introduced 4GB and 30GB data bundles at R 249 and R 699, respectively. Furthermore, Cell C reduced the prices of the 1GB, 1.5GB, 2GB, 3GB, 10GB and 20GB data bundles. For example, the 1GB prepaid 30-day standard data bundle had a 10.5% decrease in price from R 95 to R 85.

In the voice services market, Cell C filed amendments to the flat-rate tariffs of the MegaBonus and UltraBonus tariff plans. The flat-rate of the MegaBonus tariff plan was increased by 45.3% from R 1.72 to R 2.50 per minute, while the UltraBonus flat-rate was increased by 25% from R 2 to R 2.50 per minute. The Authority also received a number of notifications regarding the introduction and/or amendment of voice bundles from the Mobile Network Operators (MNOs). For example, MTN filed its prepaid Personalised Bozza Talk Bundles, wherein it offers voice bundles with low effective rates based on their individual spend profiles and/or locations in the country.

The National State of Disaster is still in place and as such the ICT COVID-19 National Disaster Regulations, 2020 which prescribe minimum standards which licensees must follow during this period were in force until 10 November 2021. There were amendments of these Regulations during the period under review

which were published on 31 August 2021². The 2020 Regulations were repealed by the ICT COVID-19 National State of Disaster Regulations, 2021 published on 11 November 2021³. The current Regulations did not extend the validity of the temporary radio frequency spectrum licences issued in April 2020⁴ and these licences were terminated on 30 November 2021. As such, licensees were required to apply for the assignment of provisional radio frequency spectrum licence and pay pro-rated radio frequency spectrum licence fees for the period commencing on 01 December 2021 to 30 June 2022. Furthermore, a licensee assigned with provisional spectrum in terms of the ICT COVID-19 National State of Disaster Regulations⁵, must maintain network connectivity in line with regulatory requirements for the schools allocated respectively to it by the Authority, free of charge, for a period of 12 months from the date determined by the Authority.

The Authority also conducted a brief comparative analysis of fibre packages for current prices⁶ and average prices of four different fibre line speeds offered by fibre service providers on various fibre networks. For example, on the 20/20Mbps line speed, Cybersmart's 20/20Mbps package on the Vodacom network is priced 47% above the average of R 777, while Cybersmart's Big Bay MPOA 20/20Mbps package is priced 49% below average for the same line speed.

1. Introduction

In terms of the Standard Terms and Conditions for Individual Licences Regulations (*Government Gazette No. 33294*) of 2010, as amended and End-User and Subscriber Service Charter Regulations (*Government Gazette No. 39898*) of 2016, as amended, individual licensees are required to file notifications of tariffs and promotional tariffs with the Authority, seven (7) days prior to launching them in the market. The analysis contained in this report is based on prepaid tariffs that were filed in accordance with the aforementioned Regulations and regulation 4 of the ICT COVID-19 National Disaster Regulations, 2020, as amended and ICT COVID-19 National State of Disaster Regulations, 2021; during the period of 01 July 2021 to 31 December 2021.

The purpose of the report is to highlight the different prepaid tariff plans (prices and product offerings) which were filed during the period under review. The aim of this report is to ensure that there is retail price transparency in line with object 2(n) of the ECA which is to "promote the interest of consumers with regard to the price, quality and the variety of electronic communication services". This would enable customers to make an informed choice, in terms of tariff plan preferences and/or preferred service providers based on their different offerings.

This report provides an update of the 2021/22 FY second quarter (Q2) Tariff Analysis Report, and it also highlights changes and new prepaid standard and promotional mobile voice and data plans and tariffs and month-to-month (MtM) LTE, Wi-Fi plans and monthly Fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) packages that were filed by the different Individual Licensees during the period under review.

This report is categorised into the following sections:

 Section 2 provides an analysis of the notifications received, which are categorised into Standard prepaid data tariffs, Promotional prepaid data tariffs, Standard prepaid voice tariffs, Promotional prepaid voice tariffs, Standard prepaid integrated bundles, Promotional prepaid integrated bundles, MtM LTE and Wi-Fi tariff plans, Standard MtM FTTH tariff plans, Promotional MtM FTTH tariff plans, Comparative Analysis of Fibre Products; and

Section 3 provides concluding remarks.

An overview of other⁷ prepaid tariff notifications filed during the period under review is then depicted in Annexure A and it shows that there has potentially been competition in terms of the promotions offered by the licensees in the market. Annexure B shows prepaid promotions and tariff plans which ended during the period under review.

2. Analysis of Tariffs Notified to the Authority

There were mainly five types of prepaid tariff plans that were on offer in the market during the period under review, these are:

- Standard prepaid data tariffs;
- · Promotional prepaid data tariffs;
- Standard prepaid voice tariffs;
- Standard prepaid integrated bundles; and
- Promotional prepaid integrated bundles.

The analysis of the standard and promotional prepaid data and voice tariffs is presented in sub-sections 2.1 to 2.4. Sub-section 2.5 looks at the standard and promotional prepaid integrated bundles. Sub-section 2.6 looks at LTE and Wi-Fi tariff plans offered on a MtM basis, and a brief analysis of MtM FTTH plans and offerings is provided in sub-section 2.7.

2.1. Analysis of Standard Prepaid Data Tariffs and Data Bundles Tariff Plan Changes

2.1.1. Prepaid Data plans

This sub-section provides an updated analysis and highlights changes, if any, of prepaid data plans and prices charged by the four main MNOs and Mobile Virtual Network Operators ("MVNOs") subsequent to the previous 2021/22FY Q2 Biannual Tariff Analysis Report. Therefore, this sub-section is divided into two parts, i.e., 2.1.1.1, which shows the prepaid data prices for bundles offered by the MNOs and 2.1.1.2, which shows the prepaid data prices for bundles offered by MVNOs filed with the Authority in the period under review.

2.1.1.1. Prepaid Data Prices for bundles offered by MNOs

2.1.1.1.1. Prepaid 30-day validity period data bundle

This section shows the prices for the 30-day standard prepaid data bundles offers and provides a comparative analysis of these prepaid plans which are offered by Vodacom, MTN, Cell C and Telkom Mobile, collectively referred to as MNOs. Tables 2 and 3 indicate the difference in terms of absolute value (Variance in Rands) of the data charges in terms of in-bundle (i.e., labelled Current Prices) plans and out-of-bundle rates (OOB) of the same volume of data (i.e., the OOB equivalent price). Also shown in the tables are prices (tariff rate) of each megabyte per volume of data, i.e., the in-bundle rates. These tables also indicate and compare price changes, if any, from the previous prices found in the 2021/22 FY Q2 Biannual Tariff Analysis Report, which was published on ICASA's website on 01 October 2021⁸.

In the period under review, the Authority received amendment notifications with respect to 30-day standard prepaid data bundles from all the four major MNOs.

MTN filed its amendment notifications on 20 July 2021 and 20 August 2021. Telkom Mobile, Vodacom and Cell C filed their amendment notifications on 24 August 2021, 22 September 2021 and 29 September 2021, respectively. It should be noted that MTN and Telkom Mobile's amendments were incorporated in the 2021/22 FY Q2 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report. This was done to ensure that the report is not retrospective, it was imperative that such significant amendments be incorporated in the report to reflect data prices that were prevailing in the market. The 2021/22 FY Q2 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report can be found on the Authority's website⁹.

Vodacom's amendment entailed the price reductions of the 2GB, 50GB and 100GB data bundles. Vodacom also introduced the 4GB, 6GB, 15GB and 30GB data bundles. Table 2 below shows that Vodacom reduced the price of its 30-day standard prepaid 2GB data bundle by R 10 or 6.3% from R 159 to R 149. The operator's new 4GB is priced at R 249, and it is the only MNO that offers a 4GB standard 30-day prepaid data bundle. The 5GB data bundle offered at R 349 was replaced by the 6GB data bundle offered for the same price, which means that there was an increase of data volume by 1GB or 20% at no extra charge. It is worth noting that Vodacom and MTN currently offer their 6GB data bundles for the same monetary value, whereas Cell C offers same data volume for R 299, which is R 100 or 14.3% less than what the two operators charge. The 15GB and 30GB data bundles were introduced in the market at R 529 and R 699, respectively. Vodacom also reduced the prices of the 30-day standard prepaid 50GB and 100GB data bundles by 46.7% and 58.4%, from R 1 499 and R 2 399 to R 799 and R 999, respectively, as shown in the table.

Cell C's amendment entailed the replacement of the 80MB, 150MB, 325MB and 800MB data bundles. The operator introduced the 100MB, 200MB, 350MB, 500MB, 4GB and 30GB data bundles. The amendment also entailed price reductions of the 1GB, 1.5GB, 2GB, 3GB, 10GB and 20GB data bundles. For example, the 1.5GB prepaid 30-day standard prepaid data bundle had a 33.6% decrease in price from R 149 to R 99. Table 3 below shows that Cell C increased the data bundle volume

of its 30-day standard prepaid 80MB and 150MB to 100MB and 200MB, while the price remained unchanged at R 15 and R 29, respectively. The 325MB data bundle offered at R 49 was replaced by the 350MB data bundle offered at R 45, which is priced at R 4 less yet offering 25MB more data volume than the previously offered 325MB data bundle. The operator reintroduced its 500MB at R 65, replacing the 800MB data bundle which was offered at R 80. The 1GB data bundle price was reduced by R 10 or 10.5% from R 95 to R 85. Cell C also reduced the prices of the 30-day standard prepaid 1.5GB, 2GB, 3GB, 10GB and 20GB data bundles as shown in the table.

Tables 2 and 3 above shows that Cell C, MTN and Vodacom currently offer their 30-day standard prepaid 200MB data bundle for R 29, which can be translated to an in-bundle rate (i.e., tariff rate per megabyte) of R 0.15 per MB. Telkom currently offers its 150MB data bundle for R 29, therefore having the highest in-bundle rate of R 0.19 per MB when compared to the other three MNOs.

Cell C currently charges the lowest on the 300MB to 350MB data bundle range, offering its 350MB data bundle for R 45, which can be translated to a R 0.13 per MB in-bundle rate. Vodacom and MTN offer their respective 350MB data bundles for R 49, which can be translated to a R 0.14 per MB in-bundle rate. Telkom Mobile still offers its 300MB data bundle for R 49, therefore its in-bundle rate of R 0.16 per MB is the highest on the 300MB to 350MB data bundle range.

The most affordable 30-day prepaid 500MB data bundle is currently offered by Cell C, at R 65, with an in-bundle rate of R 0.13 per MB. The operator reintroduced the 500MB data bundle in the period under review. MTN, Telkom Mobile and Vodacom all have their respective 500MB data bundle prices at R 69, which is R 4 or 6.2% higher than what Cell C charges.

Cell C reduced the price of its 30-day standard prepaid 1GB data bundle by R 10 or 10.5%, from R 95 to R 85 (i.e., R 0.08 per MB in-bundle rate), which is equivalent to what Vodacom and MTN charge for the same data volume. However, Telkom Mobile offers the most affordable 30-day standard prepaid 1GB data bundle priced at R 79.

Cell C also reduced the price of its 30-day standard prepaid 1.5GB data bundle by R 50 or 33.6%, from R 149 to R 99 (i.e., R 0.06 per MB in-bundle rate), making it equivalent to what MTN charges for the same data volume. However, Telkom Mobile offers the most affordable 30-day standard prepaid 1.5GB data bundle priced at R 89.

MTN, Vodacom and Cell C currently offer their respective 30-day standard prepaid 2GB data bundles at R 149, which is translatable to a R 0.07 per MB in-bundle rate. Telkom Mobile offers the most affordable 2GB data bundle at R 139, which

translates to R 0.07 per MB in-bundle rate. The three operators charge R 10 or 7.2% more than what Telkom Mobile charges for the 2GB data bundle.

Cell C's 30-day standard prepaid 3GB data bundle was reduced by R 50 or 20.1% from R 249 to R 199, making it the most affordable 3GB data bundle along with Telkom Mobile and MTN, with their respective in-bundle rates at R 0.06 per MB. Vodacom offers the least affordable 30-day standard prepaid 3GB data bundle at R 229 (i.e., R 0.07 per MB in-bundle rate), which is R 30 or 15.1% higher than what Cell C, Telkom Mobile and MTN currently charge.

MTN and Telkom Mobile currently charge the least for the 30-day standard prepaid 5GB data bundle, pricing it at R 299 (i.e., R 0.06 per MB in-bundle rate). It should be noted that Vodacom and Cell C currently do not offer the 5GB data bundle, however they offer 4GB and 6GB data bundles. Vodacom's 4GB and 6GB data bundles are priced at R 249 and R 349, respectively, while Cell C's 4GB and 6GB data bundles for R 249 and R 299, respectively. Therefore, priced at R 299 (i.e., R 0.05 per MB in-bundle rate), Cell C's 6GB data bundle has the lowest in-bundle rate in the 4GB to 6GB data bundle range.

Cell C also reduced the price of its 30-day standard prepaid 10GB data bundle by R 30 or 6% from R 499 to R 469. Therefore, all four MNOs currently offer the standard 30-day prepaid 10GB data bundle for R 469.

Cell C's 30-day standard prepaid 20GB data bundle realised a R 200 or 25% price reduction from R 799 to R 599. This amendment resulted in Cell C and MTN offering the most affordable 20GB data bundle among the four MNOs. Telkom Mobile offers its 20GB data bundle for R 699, which is 16.7% higher than what Cell C and MTN charge. It should be noted that Vodacom's 20GB data bundle offered at R 699 was replaced with a 30GB data bundle which is also priced at R 699 as the previous 20GB. This means that customers receive 10GB or 50% more data while the price remains unchanged.

It is also worth noting that Cell C introduced a 30-day standard prepaid 30GB data bundle which it offers for R 699. Therefore, for R 699 customers receive 10GB

more on Vodacom and Cell C than what Telkom Mobile customers receive, since Telkom Mobile charges R 699 for a standard 30-day prepaid 20GB data bundle.

Vodacom's 30-day standard prepaid 50GB data bundle realised a R 700 or 46.7% price reduction from R 1 499 to R 799, which is the same as MTN's amendment that was filed with the Authority on 20 July 2021. The subsequent price adjustment by Vodacom is likely to be an indication of the operator's effort to charge competitive prices in the market. Vodacom and MTN currently offer the most affordable 50GB data bundle among the four operators. Cell C still offers 40GB data bundle at R 1 199, which is R 400 or 50% more than what Vodacom and MTN charge for their 50GB data bundles. Telkom Mobile offers the least affordable 50GB data bundle at R 1 499, which is R 700 or 87.6% more than what Vodacom and MTN charge for the same data volume.

Vodacom also reduced the price of its 30-day standard prepaid 100GB data bundle by R 1 400 or 58.4% from R 2 399 to R 999. It is worth noting that the operator's 100GB data bundle price reduction follows that of MTN's, which was filed with the Authority on 20 July 2021, where MTN reduced its 100GB data bundle by R 1 500 60% from R 2 499 to R 999. Therefore, Vodacom's price reduction is perceived to be the operator's effort to remain competitive to its rival. It is evident that increased competition among rival firms reduces prices/cost to communicate and promotes innovation in the market. Telkom Mobile currently prices its 100GB data bundle at R 2 999, which is R 1 500 or 150.2% more than what Vodacom and MTN charge for their 100GB data bundles. Cell C offers the least affordable 100GB data bundle at R 2 999, which is R 2 000 or 200.2% more than what Vodacom and MTN charge for the same data volume.

2.1.1.1.2. Year-on-Year Changes on selected 30-day Standard Prepaid Data Bundles




Figure 1: Y-o-Y Data Price and volume changes for 150MB standard 30-day prepaid data bundles

Figures 1 to 4 depict year-on-year changes that happened on the 150MB, 500MB, 1GB and 2GB 30-day standard prepaid data bundles, respectively, since the 2020/21 FY Q4 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report.

In the 2020/21 FY Q4 to 2021/22 FY Q4 period, Vodacom and Cell C filed amendments to their 150MB prepaid data bundles wherein they upsized their respective data bundles by 50MB while the prices remained unchanged at R 29. This translated to a decrease in the in-bundle rate from R 0.19 per MB to R 0.15 per MB. MTN also amended its 200MB data bundle price on 20 July 2021 from R 39 to R 29, therefore the in-bundle rate decreased from R 0.20 per MB to R 0.15 per MB. Telkom Mobile currently offers its 150MB data bundle at R 29, which is

the least affordable bundle in the 150MB to 200MB range, with an in-bundle rate of R 0.19 per MB.




Figure 2: Y-o-Y Data Price changes for 500MB standard 30-day prepaid data bundles

Figure 2 above depicts that in the 2020/21 FY Q4 to 2021/22 FY Q4 period, three of the four operators amended their 500MB data bundles, namely Vodacom, MTN and Cell C. Vodacom amended the price of its 500MB data bundle, reducing it by R 10 or 12.7% from R 79 to R 69, which can be translated to an in-bundle rate of R 0.14 per MB. MTN also revised the price of its 500MB data bundle in the period under review wherein the price was reduced by R 6 or 8% from R 75 to R 69. Cell C replaced its 800MB data bundle which it offered for R 80 with a 500MB data bundle offered for R 65, thus making it the most affordable 500MB among the four operators. No amendment has been made by Telkom Mobile on its 500MB in the 2020/21 FY Q4 to 2021/22 FY Q4 period, which is still offered for R 69. On average, the 30-day standard prepaid 500MB data bundle is priced at R 68, based on the prices for this data bundle across the four MNO's.




Figure 3: Y-o-Y Data Price changes for 1GB standard 30-day prepaid data bundles

Figure 3 above shows that all four operators amended their respective 30-day standard prepaid 1GB data bundles in the 2020/21 FY Q4 to 2021/22 FY Q4 period. The largest price decrease in both absolute and percentage terms occurred on Telkom Mobile, wherein the 1GB data bundle price decreased by R 20 or 20.2% from R 99 to R 79, making it the most affordable 1GB prepaid data bundle amongst the four operators. Vodacom and MTN reduced the prices of their 1GB data bundles, both by R 14 or 14.1%, from R 99 to R 85. Cell C also reduced its 1GB data bundle price on 29 September 2021, by R 10 or 10.5%, from R 95 to R 85. On average the 30-day standard prepaid 1GB data bundle currently costs R 83.50, based on the prices for this data bundle across the four MNO's.

Figure 4 above shows the price adjustments that occurred on the 30-day standard prepaid 2GB data bundles in the 2020/21 FY Q4 to 2021/22 FY Q4 period. On 29 March 2021, Vodacom reintroduced its 2GB data bundle which was reported in the 2021/22 FY Q2 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report¹⁰ at the price of R 159. The operator reduced the price of the 2GB data bundle in the period under review by R 10 or 6.3% to R 149. MTN reduced the price of its 2GB data bundle by R 40 or 21.2%, from R 189 to R 149, therefore with an in-bundle rate of R 0.07 per MB. Cell C also reduced its 2GB data bundle by R 50 or 25.1%, from R 199 to R 149 (i.e., R 0.05 per MB in-bundle rate). Telkom Mobile's 1GB data bundle remains the lowest among the four operators, price data bundle at R 139. On average, the 30-day standard prepaid 2GB data bundles currently cost R 147.

Table 4 below shows a summary of the salient changes that the Authority has observed for the 30-day standard prepaid data bundles over a period of a year

2.1.1.1.3. Other standard prepaid data bundles offered by MNO's

2.1.1.1.3.1. MTN Prepaid Personalised Data Bundles

The Authority received four notifications regarding MTN Prepaid Personalised Data Bundles in the period under review on 01 July 2021, 06 July 2021, 20 July 2021, and 26 July 2021. The operator added new daily, weekly and monthly prepaid data bundles in the plan as per the notifications filed on 01 July 2021 and 06 July 2021. The notification received on 20 July 2021 entailed an amendment of the monthly Prepaid Personalised Data Bundles. MTN further amended the monthly data bundles on 26 July 2021, wherein it included Night Express data bundles on selected data bundles. Table 5 shows a sample 13 of the additional data bundles, and table 6 shows a sample of the amended monthly data bundles. MTN's preceding notification with respect to this plan was filed with the Authority on 30 April 2021.

The bundles shown in the table above are offered to selected customers at varying data volumes in accordance to their spending profiles. For example, MTN may offer selected customers a weekly 200MB, 220MB or 400MB data bundle, depending on their spend profiles, for a price of R 20. Customers benefit from the low in-bundle rates attached to the Personalised Data Bundles, with the highest being R 0.17 per MB, therefore customers receive more value for money.

Table 6 above shows that selected data bundles include Night Express data allocation. For example, customers that are offered the 2048MB data bundle (effort 1) receive an additional 2048MB to use between 00h00 to 05h00.

MTN's additional Personalised Data Bundles filed on 01 July 2021 were introduced in the market on 12 July 2021, while those filed on 06 July 2021 were introduced in the market on 15 July 2021. MTN's Personalised Data Bundles amendment filed on 26 July 2021 came to effect 04 August 2021.

2.1.1.1.3.2. Vodacom Pay Once Data Bundles

Vodacom's amendment to its Pay Once Data Bundles was filed with the Authority on 13 July 2021. The previous notification regarding the Pay Once Data Bundles was filed on 15 July 2020. The amendment entailed the price reduction of the packages offered. The plan offers customers data bundles that are paid for on a once-off basis and then allocated to customers monthly for a period of six or twelve months as shown in table 7 below.

The table above shows that the 10GB package had the largest tariff decrease in both absolute and percentage terms, decreasing by R 3 500 or 58.3%, from R 5 999 to R 2 499. Vodacom's Pay Once Data Bundles can be compared to Cell

C's Upfront Payment Bundles (filed with the Authority on 11 November 2020). For example, Vodacom offers 1GB Pay Once Data Bundle at R 599, while Cell C offers its 1GB Upfront Payment Bundle at R 799, which is R 200 or 33.4% more than what Vodacom charges. However, it should be noted that Cell C rewards customers with a free additional monthly recurring data bundle equivalent to the standard data allocation. Vodacom's amendment to its Pay Once Data Bundles came to effect on 22 July 2021.

2.1.1.1.3.3. Vodacom Time Based Bundles

Vodacom filed its new Time Based Bundles with the Authority on 15 July 2021, wherein it offers prepaid and hybrid customers data bundles of varying validity periods that can be used on specific time intervals (time zones) as shown in table 8 below.

The table above shows that customers can purchase a 1GB data bundle valid for 30 days to use during the 8-hour window (i.e., 09h00 to 17h00), at a price of R 41. It should be noted that unused/remaining data is utilised on the following days of the bundle's validity period until it is depleted. Customers can choose data bundles in accordance with their needs for digital services at specific times, especially when they are away from fixed broadband services. Customers can purchase the Time Based Bundles via the *123*4# USSD or the my Vodacom App. Vodacom introduced its Time Based Bundles in the market on 24 July 2021.

2.1.1.1.3.4. Cell C WhatsApp Data Bundle

On 23 July 2021 Cell C filed an amendment to the WhatsApp Data Bundle with the Authority. The amendment entailed a reduction of the validity of the Cell C WhatsApp Data Bundle from 7 days to 3 days which negatively impacted customers as they have a shorter period to utilise the data bundle.

The amendment of Cell C's WhatsApp Data Bundle became effective on 04 August 2021.

2.1.1.1.3.5. FNB Connect Bundle

Cell C¹⁴ filed an amendment of the FNB Connect Bundle with the Authority on 20 August 2021. The amendment entailed the price increase of FNB Connect Bundle 1GB data bundles, which is set out in table 9 below.

The table above shows that there were price adjustments on FNB Connect's Bundles, for the 1-day and 7-day 1GB data bundles which were increased by 26% and 4% respectively, and this means that the cost to communicate also increased for customers who purchase these bundles. The FNB Connect Bundle 1GB 7-day data bundle prices are competitive when compared to those charged by the big four MNOs, for instance Cell C offers its 7-day 1GB data bundle for R 65 which is 18.2% more than what FNB Connect charges. Vodacom's 7-day 1GB data bundle is priced at R 80, which is 45.5% more than FNB Connect's price for the same data bundle volume. MTN's 7-day 1GB data bundle is priced at R 70, which is 27.3% more than FNB Connect's price for the same data bundle volume. Telkom's 7-day 1GB data bundle is priced at R 75, which is 36.4% more than FNB Connect's price for the same data bundle volume. The amendment of the FNB Connect Bundle became effective on 10 October 2021.

2.1.1.1.3.6. Vodacom Weekly Data Bundles

Vodacom's amendment of its Data Bundle portfolio was filed with the Authority on 22 September 2021, and it entailed the adjustment of the pricing of selected

monthly¹⁵ and weekly data bundles and the introduction of new data bundles. Table 10 below shows the amendment to the weekly data bundles.

On the weekly data bundles, the largest tariff decrease (in absolute value terms) occurred on the 2GB data bundle, reducing by R 21 (or 17.5%), from R 120 to R 99. Vodacom's weekly data bundle can be compared to other operators' 1GB data bundles. For example, Cell C's weekly 1GB bundle is priced at R 65, which is R 4 or 5.8% less than what Vodacom charges. MTN and Telkom Mobile's weekly 1GB bundles are priced at R 70 and R 75, which is R 1 (or 1.4%) and R 6 (or 8.7%) more than Vodacom's 1GB weekly data bundle, respectively.

Vodacom's data amendment came to effect on 01 October 2021.

2.1.1.1.3.7. Cell C 30-Day Data Bundles

Cell C filed an amendment of its 30-day Data Bundles with the Authority on 29 September 2021. The Cell C 30-day Data Bundles consist of 30-day Base bundles and WhatsApp Boost 30-day Bundles. The amendment entailed the introduction of new 30-day Base data bundles and WhatsApp Boost 30-day data bundle packages and price reductions on certain 30-day Base data bundle packages. Table 11 below details the new bundle packages and the price reductions which occurred on the Cell C 30-day Data Bundles.

The largest price reduction on the Cell C 30-day Base bundles in percentage terms of 33.6% occurred on the 1.5GB bundle. The 1GB 30-day Base Bundle can be compared to Vodacom and MTN's 30-day 1GB bundles which are also priced at R 85. Telkom's 1GB 30-day bundle priced at R 79 is the cheapest among the MNOs. The amendment of the Cell C 30-day Data Bundles became effective on 08 October 2021.

2.1.1.1.3.8. Vodacom Prepaid Monthly Recurring Bundles

Vodacom filed an amendment to its Prepaid Monthly Recurring Bundles with the Authority on 20 October 2021, wherein it upsized data bundle allocations and reduced prices of selected data bundles. The preceding notification regarding Prepaid Monthly Recurring Bundles was filed on 16 April 2021. Table 12 below details the amendment.

As shown in the table above, the 5GB data bundle for example, was upsized by 2.2GB while the price remained unchanged at R 349. This translates to a decrease in the in-bundle rate from R 0.07 per MB to R 0.05 per MB. The operator also decreased the prices of the 50GB and 100GB data bundles. For example, the 100GB bundle had a R 1 400 or 58.4% price decrease from R 2 399 to R 999. Vodacom's amendment to its Prepaid Monthly Recurring Bundles came to effect on 29 October 2021.

2.1.1.2. Daily and Weekly Standard Prepaid Data Prices for bundles offered by MNOs and MVNOs

This section generally provides an updated comparative analysis of standard daily and weekly mobile data bundles offered by MNOs and MVNOs in light of what was filed in the period under review and also considering what other MNOs charge for similar data bundles. In the period under review, the Authority did not receive any notification regarding the daily¹⁶ mobile data bundles, therefore the update on this section is only with respect to the weekly standard prepaid data bundles.

2.1.1.2.1. Weekly Data Bundles

In the period under review, Vodacom filed weekly data bundles as analysed in 2.1.1.1.2.7. These new prices are compared in this sub-section to the prevailing prices of other MNOs as per their previous filings of standard prepaid weekly data bundles.

Previous notifications for standard weekly data plans were received from the other licensees in periods which are outside of the review period, for instance, Telkom Mobile, filed on 19 September 2019, MTN, filed on 31 May 2018, Cell C initially

filed on 24 October 2018 and the most recent amendment was filed on 16 February 2021.

Vodacom's replacement of the 100MB with 120MB data bundle while keeping the price unchanged at R 17, which has made this MNO offer more value for money than the other operators on the 100MB to 150MB range of weekly data bundles.

The operator has the lowest in-bundle rate of R 0.14, which is R 0.01 per MB lower when compared to the other operators, shown in table 14 above.

On the 200MB to 250MB range of weekly data bundles, Cell C and FNB Connect offer the most affordable 250MB data bundles, both at R 25 with in-bundle rates of R 0.10 per MB. Vodacom and Telkom Mobile offer their 250MB data bundles for R 29 and R 30, respectively, with both in-bundle rates at R 0.12 per MB. MTN's 200MB priced at R 25 which translates to the highest in-bundle rate at R 0.13 per MB, in the 200MB to 250MB range of weekly data bundles, as shown in table 14 above.

FNB Connect charges the least for the 500MB weekly data bundle, offering it for R 35 which translates to the lowest in-bundle rate of R 0.07 per MB. Cell C has the second lowest in-bundle rate of R 0.08 per MB, although it is offering a 600MB data bundle at R 50. MTN offers the least affordable 500MB data bundle at R 55, which translates to the highest in-bundle rate of R 0.11 per MB. Vodacom and Telkom Mobile offer their 500MB weekly data bundle for R 49 and R 50, respectively, which translates to a R 0.10 per MB in-bundle rate.

On the weekly 1GB bundle FNB Connect currently offers the lowest price of R 55 among the tabulated operators, with the in-bundle rate of R 0.05 per MB. Cell C, Vodacom, MTN and Telkom Mobile's weekly 1GB bundles are priced at R 65, R 69, R 70, and R 75, which is R 10 (or 18.2%), R 14 (or 25.5%), R 15 (or 27.3%) and R 20 (or 36.4%) more than FNB Connect's 1GB weekly data bundle, respectively.

Vodacom's reduction of its weekly 2GB data bundle from R 120 to R 99 has resulted in Telkom Mobile's 2GB being priced the highest among the tabulated operators, offering its bundle for R 1 more than Vodacom, MTN and FNB Connect. Cell C charges the most affordable price of R 95 for the standard weekly 2GB data bundle, when compared to the tabulated operators.

Vodacom is currently the only operator offering a weekly 5GB data bundle which is priced at R 199 (i.e., R 0.04 per MB in-bundle rate).

2.1.2. Over-the-Top (OTT) Service Offerings

This section focuses on Over-the-Top (OTT) services which are used by a customer to ride on top of an electronic communications network services of a licensed operator to which the customer is connected¹⁷. In order to capitalise on the growth in uptake of OTT services, licensed operators have launched various product offerings so as to maximise their data revenues. The sub-section below discusses the OTT linked product offerings, which MNOs filed notifications for, during the period under review.

2.1.2.1. Cell C Daily WhatsApp Bundle

Cell C filed its Daily WhatsApp Bundle with the Authority on 22 July 2021. The Cell C Daily WhatsApp Bundle offers customers a 100MB daily bundle that is valid until midnight from the day of purchase. Table 15 below sets out the details of the Cell C Daily WhatsApp Bundle.

2.1.2.2. Vodacom VodaBucks GSM Store

Vodacom filed its amendment to the VodaBucks GSM Store plan on 02 September 2021 wherein it added new VodaBucks data bundles. The operator's preceding filing regarding the VodaBucks GSM Store plan was filed with the Authority on 20 May 2021. The plan offers prepaid customers (including hybrid and post-paid customers) standard data, URL-specific data and/or voice bundles that can be

As shown in the table above, customers can for example, purchase a 7-day 1GB Video Ticket data bundle as a combination of VodaBucks earned and R 17 monetary value. This allows customers to benefit from their loyalty through discounted purchases. Vodacom's VodaBucks GSM Store bundles were filed in terms of the ICT COVID-19 National Disaster Regulations and therefore came to effect on 11 September 2021.

2.1.2.3. MTN Prepaid Social Bundles

MTN filed the amendment to its Prepaid Social Bundles with the Authority on 26 October 2021. The amendment entailed the addition of new data bundles, the upsizing of selected data packages and the adjustment of prices. Table 17 below details the amendment.

The above shows that MTN introduced the 1GB WhatsApp bundles with 1-day, 3-day, 7-day and 30-day validity periods. MTN also increased allocated data on selected data bundles while keeping the prices unchanged. For example, the 30-day URL-specific 500MB data bundle was upsized by 500MB to 1GB while the price remained unchanged at R 20, resulting in the decrease in the in-bundle rate from R 0.04 per MB to R 0.02 per MB. Customers also benefit from the low in-bundle rates attached to the Prepaid Social Bundles ranging from R 0.01 to R 0.04 per MB.

MTN's Social Bundles can be compared to Vodacom Ticket bundles. For example, Vodacom offers its 3-day 100MB WhatsApp Bundle for R 6 which translates to a R 0.06 per MB in-bundle rate, while MTN offers its 3-day 150MB WhatsApp bundle for R 5 which translates to a R 0.03 per MB in-bundle rate, therefore MTN offers customers more value for money. On the other hand, both operators offer their monthly 1GB WhatsApp bundles for R 35, while Cell C offers its monthly 1GB

WhatsApp bundle for R 29, which is R 6 or 17.1% less than what Vodacom and MTN charge for the same data volume.

MTN's amendment to its Prepaid Social Bundles came to effect on 05 November 2021.

2.1.2.4. Vodacom Open View Data Bundles

The Authority received Vodacom's Open View Data Bundles on 04 November 2021. The bundles are offered as once-off 30-day data bundles and are available for purchase to Open View customers with a prepaid SIM card provisioned for the ETV price plan. Table 18 shows the Open View Data Bundles.

As shown in the table above Vodacom offers Open View customers data bundles that are inclusive of standard data and Night Owl data. For example, the 2GB data bundle package includes 2GB of standard data and 2GB of Night Owl data, thus resulting in the in-bundle rate of R 0.02 per MB. It should be noted that if customers opt for out-of-bundle billing they will be charged an OOB rate of R 0.49 per MB. Vodacom introduced its Open View Data Bundles on 13 November 2021.

2.1.2.5. Vodacom Just 4 You WhatsApp Ticket Bundles

The Authority received Vodacom's notification on the Just 4 You WhatsApp Ticket Bundles on 09 November 2021. The bundles comprise of WhatsApp data bundles and on-net voice minutes. These are available to prepaid customers on a once-off basis. Table 19 below details the bundles.

As shown in the table above, the new bundles have a 1-day or a 7-day validity. For example, at a price of R 17 customers can get a 7-day 200MB WhatsApp data and 120 Vodacom (i.e., on-net) minutes. Vodacom introduced its Just 4 You WhatsApp Ticket Bundles in the market on 18 November 2021.

2.1.2.6. MTN Personalised Social Bundle Offers

MTN filed its additional Personalised Social Bundles with the Authority on 15 November 2021. The operator added new 1-day, 3-day, 7-day and 30-day standard data bundles and 1-day to 3-day WhatsApp bundles. The bundle(s) offered to the customers are based on their location (different towns or suburbs in South Africa) and spending profiles. Table 20 below shows a sample of the additional Personalised Social Bundles. More information regarding this offer and its terms and conditions can be obtained from the operator's website¹⁸.

Table 20 above shows that for a monetary value of R 3, customers can be offered weekly Personalised PAYG Social Bundles with data volumes of 60MB, 70MB or 120MB.

MTN's Personalised Social Bundles were filed in terms of the ICT COVID-19 National Disaster Regulations and therefore they came to effect on 22 November 2021.

2.1.2.7. Cell C MediaPlay Subscription Charges and MediaPlay Data Bundles

Cell C filed its MediaPlay Subscription Charges and MediaPlay Data Bundles with the Authority on 16 November 2021. These offer customers MediaPlay Bundles ranging from 250MB to 3GB and are priced between R 15 and R 130 providing access to a streaming video, audio and content service via a web-based browser across compatible end-user devices connected to the Internet. Table 21 below details the bundles and prices available on the Cell C MediaPlay Subscription Charges and MediaPlay Data Bundles.

2.1.2.8. MTN Social Bundles - Instagram Bundles

MTN filed additional Social Bundles with the Authority on 25 November 2021. The operator introduced new Instagram bundles in its Social Bundles suite. It is worth noting that MTN initially filed its Social Bundles with the Authority on 22 November 2017. Table 22 below shows the new Instagram bundles.

The in-bundle rates, as shown in the table above, range from R 0.01 – R 0.03 per MB. Customers can either purchase daily, weekly and/or monthly Instagram bundles. It should be noted that these bundles deplete when used on both Instagram and Facebook platforms due to Facebook's system design which enables Instagram traffic to run on the same system. MTN's additional Social Bundles came to effect on 06 December 2021.

2.2. Analysis of Promotional Prepaid Data Tariffs

This section analyses the promotional prepaid data tariffs which were filed during the period under review. The promotional tariff plans are temporary and time-bound in nature, with generally a start and end date, which is also subject to being extended. The tariff/s analysed in this sub-section are those which had significant amendments effected and continue to be made available to customers post the report publication date (i.e., by or after 31 March 2022) while other promotional prepaid data tariffs, filed in the period under review are found on either Annexure A or Annexure B, depending on whether the promotion seized to exist in the market before or after 31 December 2021.

2.2.1.MTN Hourly 1GB Promotion

MTN filed its Hourly 1GB Promotion with the Authority on 19 July 2021, wherein it offers 1GB hourly data bundle at the price of R 1. MTN aims to assist with reducing the impact of the pandemic on telecommunications services and lower costs to communicate by providing financial relief and affordable access to digital services. Customers can only purchase the hourly 1GB on the MTN App and MoMo App.

MTN's Hourly 1GB Promotion was filed in terms of the ICT COVID-19 National Disaster Regulations, 2020, and therefore came to effect on 22 July 2021 and will be in the market until further notice.

2.2.2. MTN Bundle Bonanza Inflow Promotions

MTN filed an amendment to its Bundle Bonanza Inflow Promotions with the Authority on 26 July 2021, wherein it revised the terms and conditions of the promotions.

Previously, the promotion was applicable to each qualifying recharge for 9 months from the date of SIM activation. MTN has amended the promotional offer to limit the qualifying recharges to three. The promotional data now depletes at 200kbps while the promotional voice bundles deplete at 1.25 per minute increments. For example, the 60 minutes voice bundle depletes at 1.25 minutes per minute,

resulting in the total number of minutes of the call to be 48 minutes (60 minutes/1.25 minutes). More information regarding the Bundle Bonanza Inflow Promotions can be found on the 2019/20 FY Q4 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report¹⁹ and the 2020/21 FY Q2 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report²⁰, which are available on the Authority's website. MTN's amendment came to effect on 05 August 2021.

2.2.3. MyMTN App Migration Incentive

The Authority received the MyMTN App Migration Incentive promotion on 19 August 2021. The promotion rewards customers who upgrade to the new MyMTN App, or download the new MyMTN App, with a free 1GB data bundle valid for 1 day. The promotional offer was launched in the market on 31 August 2021 and was anticipated to be in the market until 31 December 2021. However, on 07 December 2021, MTN amended the validity of the 1GB data bundle to 1 hour and extended the promotional offer to be in the market until 31 April 2022.

2.2.4. Cell C Retention Promotion

Cell C filed its Retention Promotion with the Authority on 29 October 2021. The Cell C Retention Promotion entails data rewards ranging from 500MB to 1GB for customers who recharge for amounts ranging from R 10 to R 35. Table 23 below sets out the details of the Cell C Retention Promotion.

The Cell C Retention Promotion was launched on 01 November 2021 and will be available on the market until 30 April 2022.

2.2.4.1.1.1. MTN Bozza Bundles

MTN filed its Prepaid Bozza Bundles with the Authority on 08 November 2021. These are bundles offered to customers as part of MTN's summer campaign. The operator offers standard data, social and voice bundles, which are available through MTN MoMo, MTN Stores and selected MTN direct sales agents. Table 24 details MTN's Prepaid Bozza Bundles.

The table above shows that the in-bundle rates of promotional bundles range from R 0.01 to R 0.08 per MB, while the effective rates range from R 0.38 to R 0.25 per minute, therefore rewarding customers with value for money. For example, MTN's 30-day standard prepaid 2GB data bundle is priced R 149, while for the same monetary value, customers could receive a 30-day 10GB data bundle (with 10GB Night Express) on MTN's Prepaid Bozza Bundles plan. The Prepaid Bozza Bundles were introduced on the market on 17 November 2021.

2.3. Regulatory interventions underway to address data costs

Section 2.2 above highlighted various prepaid data bundle plans and packages and as was analysed above there has been changes in data bundle prices. Table 4 above indicated that prices have generally been declining for some of MTN, Telkom Mobile and Cell C's 30-day standard prepaid data bundles. Noticeably there are various promotions in the market which offer data services at affordable prices. Nonetheless the Authority continues to implement regulatory measures and interventions which seek to ensure that data services prices and other costs to communicate are reasonably affordable.

The sub-sections below provide an update²¹ of the regulatory interventions which are underway to address data costs.

2.3.1. The ICT COVID-19 National Disaster Regulations

In the period under review, the Authority published the ICT COVID-19 National Disaster Sixth Amendment Regulations²² on 31 August 2021 and the ICT COVID-19 National State of Disaster Regulations, 2021²³ on 11 November 2021. The former amendment Regulations extended the temporary radio frequency spectrum licences issued to certain Individual Electronic Communications Network Service ("IECNS") and Individual Electronic Communications Services ("IECS") licensees in April 2020 to 30 November 2021. However, the ICT COVID-19 National State of Disaster Regulations, 2021 did not extend the temporary radio frequency spectrum licences issued in April 2020 and such licences terminated on 30 November 2021.

As such, licensees were required to apply for the assignment of provisional radio frequency spectrum licence by no later than 16h00 on 17 November 2021. The licences are valid from 01 December 2021 until 30 June 2022 or until three months after the termination of the National State of Disaster. The licensees were required to pay pro-rated radio frequency spectrum licence fees, in terms of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Licence Fees Regulations, 2010, for the period commencing on 01 December 2021 to 30 June 2022.

A licensee assigned with provisional spectrum in terms of the ICT COVID-19 National State of Disaster Regulations, 2021 must maintain network connectivity in line with regulatory requirements for the schools allocated respectively to it by the Authority, free of charge, for a period of 12 months from the date determined by the Authority.

Mobile 2.3.2. Licensing processes for the International Telecommunications (IMT) spectrum and the WOAN

The Authority published an Invitation to Apply (ITA)²⁴ on 10 December 2021, with a closing date of 31 January 2022, and six applications have been received from Cell C, MTN, Liquid Telecoms, Rain Networks, Telkom and Vodacom. The Authority concluded the IMT spectrum auction on 17 March 2022.

In terms of the Wireless Open Access Network ("WOAN"), the Authority published a notice²⁵ on 19 November 2021, of its decision on the publication of a consultation document in respect of the amended composite ITA for an I-ECNS licence and Radio Frequency Spectrum (RFS) Licence for the purpose of operating a WOAN. The Authority reviewed and suspended the timelines relating to the licensing of the WOAN following the ITA for the IMT spectrum licensing process. This will give the Authority an opportunity to interrogate the impact of the outcomes of the consultation on the licensing of the WOAN.

The WOAN Licensing process was put on hold until the completion of the spectrum auction, during this time the Authority has been engaging other National Regulatory Authorities who have implemented a similar WOAN model in order to ensure that lessons and best practices can be learnt and where necessary adopted from other jurisdictions around the world, to ensure sustainability of the WOAN model.

On 11 March 2022, the Minister of Communications and Digital Technologies published the proposed amendment of policy on the high demand spectrum and policy direction on the licensing of a WOAN to remove the requirement to license a WOAN, for public comment. ²⁶

2.3.3. Market Inquiry into the Mobile Broadband Services Markets

The purpose of the broadband market Inquiry was to identify broadband markets or market segments susceptible to *ex ante* regulation and immediately conduct market reviews in respect of those markets.

This Inquiry was conducted in terms of section 4B of the ICASA Act read with section 67(4) of the ECA with the aim of addressing the concerns raised by various stakeholders regarding data prices, and to respond to the final policy direction on effective competition in broadband markets and the reduction of data costs. The Authority completed the Inquiry process with the publication of the Findings Document on Mobile Broadband Services Markets in March 2021.²⁷

The Authority held public hearings on the draft Mobile Broadband Services Regulations on 12 August and 13 August 2021.

Interested stakeholders, namely, Vodacom, MTN, Cell C, Telkom, Internet Services Providers Association (ISPA), Falcon & Hume (on behalf of an anonymous licensee), the Free Market Foundation and the ICT SMME Chamber (except the SACF), who submitted written representations on the draft Regulations participated in the public hearings. The next process in this process is the finalisation of the final Regulations.

2.4. Analysis of Standard Prepaid Voice Tariffs

Standard prepaid voice tariffs are categorised into three types, namely flat-rate, dynamic and on-net tariffs. The Authority received two standard prepaid voice tariff notifications from Cell C. The operator amended its UltraBonus and MegaBonus prepaid tariff plans, which are discussed in the next sub-section.

2.4.1. Flat-rate tariffs

This sub-section provides an analysis of flat-rate tariff plans filed with the Authority in the period under review. Flat-rate tariff plans charge the same retail rate for calls to any network. There are no on-net and off-net price differentials on these plans. The Authority received two notifications in the period under review, wherein Cell C amended its UltraBonus and MegaBonus prepaid tariff plans, both on 25 August 2021, these are discussed in the next subsections.

2.4.1.1. Cell C MegaBonus Tariff Plan

Cell C filed an amendment of the MegaBonus Tariff Plan with the Authority on 25 August 2021. The amendment entailed a price increase of the MegaBonus OOB voice rate. Table 25 below sets out the price increase of the OOB voice rate on the Cell C MegaBonus Tariff Plan.

The flat-rate of the MegaBonus tariff plan was increased by R 0.78 or 45.3% from R 1.72 to R 2.50 per minute. The amendment of the Cell C MegaBonus Tariff Plan became effective on 03 September 2021.

2.4.1.2. Cell C UltraBonus Tariff Plan

Cell C filed an amendment of the UltraBonus Tariff Plan with the Authority on 25 August 2021. The amendment entailed the price increase of UltraBonus OOB voice rate. Table 26 below sets out the price increase of the OOB voice rates on the Cell C UltraBonus Tariff Plan.

The flat-rate applicable to the UltraBonus tariff plan was increased by R 0.50 or 25% from R 2 to R 2.50 per minute. The amendment of the Cell C UltraBonus Tariff Plan became effective on 03 September 2021.

2.4.1.3. Flat-rate tariffs offered by MNOs

This sub-section depicts the various flat-rates voice tariff plans offered by the MNOs and provides a brief comparative analysis of the rates. As already highlighted in sub-sections 2.4.1.1 and 2.4.1.2 the Authority received two notifications in the period under review, wherein Cell C amended its UltraBonus and MegaBonus prepaid flat-rate, a graphical illustration is done in Figure 5 below of these tariff plans in comparison to other flat- rates offered by other MNOs, namely Vodacom, MTN and Telkom Mobile.

The figure above shows that amended flat-rates charged by Cell C for its UltraBonus and MegaBonus flat-rate tariffs are the highest across all depicted flat-rate tariffs offered by itself and other MNOs, with them priced at R 1.84 or 287.8% more (approximately 4 times higher) than the lowest flat-rate, namely, the Cell C 66c on Prepaid.

2.4.2. Analysis of standard voice bundles billed per minute

2.4.2.1. MTN R1 On-net Voice Bundle

MTN filed its R 1 On-net Voice Bundle with the Authority on 01 July 2021, wherein it offers customers a once-off 3 minutes on-net voice bundle for R 1. Customers are therefore offered an effective rate of R 0.33 per minute. The bundle is valid until 23h59 from the time of purchase and OOB rates apply thereafter. For example, customers on MTN's Inflow price plan save R 0.66 per minute when purchasing the voice bundle since the OOB voice rate is set at R 0.99 per minute. The operator introduced its R 1 On-net Voice Bundle on 12 July 2021.

2.4.2.2. Vodacom Daily Free Calls

Vodacom's amendment to its Daily Free Calls tariff plan was filed with the Authority on 11 August 2021, following a previous amendment, which was filed on 08 March 2019. The operator has enabled customers on the price plan to receive the Night Shift promotional benefit on condition that they recharge with R 12 or more. Vodacom free Night Shift promotional bundle enables them to make free calls between 00h00 and 05h00. Vodacom's amendment came to effect on 20 August 2021.

2.4.2.3. Telkom Mobile All-Network Voice Bundles

Telkom Mobile's amendment to its All-Network Voice Bundles was filed with the Authority on 07 September 2021. The amendment entailed price reductions for certain all-net voice minute bundles. The largest price decrease in absolute value terms occurred on the 1000 minutes All-net voice bundle which decreased by R 105. Table 27 below sets out the price amendments on the Telkom Mobile All-Network Voice Bundles.

The Telkom Mobile 25 minutes All-Net voice bundle priced at R 15 can be compared to the Cell C 25 minutes Any-net Prepaid voice bundle²⁸ which is also priced at R 15. The amendments on the Telkom All-Network Voice Bundles became effective on 20 September 2021.

Telkom filed an amendment to its FreeMe All-Network Voice Bundles on 08 September 2021 which entails the addition of the 50 minutes voice bundle in the plan. Table 28 below shows the additional Telkom FreeMe All-Network Voice Bundle.

It should be noted that the OOB voice rate of the FreeMe price plan is R 0.70 per minute for calls to other networks. Therefore, customers on the FreeMe price plan purchasing the 50-minute FreeMe All-Network Voice Bundle will save R 0.20 per minute when making calls to any network. Telkom Mobile's amendment of the FreeMe All-Network Voice Bundle came into effect on 20 September 2021.

2.4.2.5. MTN CVM Waya-waya Voice Bundles

MTN filed its new Bozza Talk Bundles with the Authority on 29 September 2021 bearing the name "Waya-waya voice bundles". However, on 06 October 2021, the operator amended the name to "Bozza Talk Bundles". These are personalised onnet voice bundles with daily and weekly validity periods. The voice bundles are available to selected prepaid customers based on their locations in different towns in the country. Table 29 below shows the bundles.

As shown in the table above, the effective rates of the personalised Bozza Talk Bundles range from R 0.01 to R 0.08 per minute. It should be noted that the bundle value will roll over to a maximum of two times the inclusive value and the excess minutes will be forfeited.

MTN's Bozza Talk Bundles were introduced in the market on 08 October 2021.

2.4.2.6. MTN Dynamic USSD All-net Voice Offers

The Authority received MTN's Dynamic USSD All-net Voice Offers on 05 October 2021. The plan entails voice bundles offered to a selected prepaid customers via the *142# USSD code, based on their spend profiles and locations in the country. Table 30 shows a sample of the voice offers. More information regarding this offer and its terms and conditions can be obtained from the operator's website²⁹.

Table above shows that the Daily 5 All-net minutes offered at R 3 has the highest effective rate of R 0.60 per minute. Therefore, customers on the MTN Inflow price plan, for example, can save at least R 0.39 per minute on calls when purchasing the USSD All-net Voice Offers as opposed to using OOB rates which charges a flat rate of R 0.99 per minute. MTN introduced the Dynamic USSD All-net Voice Offers in the market on 15 October 2021.

2.4.2.7. MTN Prepaid Personalised Bozza Talk Bundles

MTN filed its Prepaid Personalised Bozza Talk Bundles with the Authority on 08 November 2021. On 23 December 2021, MTN filed additional on-net Bozza Talk Bundles. These are voice bundle offered to customers based on their spend profiles. The operator offers personalised daily and weekly on-net voice bundles as shown in table 31 below.

As shown in the table above the highest effective rate on the Bozza Talk Bundles is R 0.38 per minute. Therefore, customers on the MTN Ska Wara Bundle Bonanza price plan, for example, can save at least R 0.61 per minute on calls when purchasing Bozza Talk Bundles as opposed to using OOB rates which charges a flat-rate of R 0.99 per minute.

The MTN Bozza Bundles which were filed on 08 November 2021 were introduced in the market on 17 November 2021, while the additional bundles filed on 23 December 2021 came into effect on 05 January 2022.

2.5. Analysis of Integrated Prepaid Tariff Plans

Integrated bundles are a combination of voice, data and/or SMS bundles sold as a unit package to customers. The five standard and promotional integrated product offerings filed with the Authority during the period under review are analysed in the next sub-sections with the focus being on standard and promotional prepaid integrated bundles.

2.5.1. Analysis of Standard Prepaid Integrated Bundles

2.5.1.1. Cell C All-In-One Prepaid Tariff Plan

Cell C filed amendments of the All-in-One Prepaid Tariff Plan with the Authority on 25 August and 03 November 2021. Cell C initially filed the All-in-One Prepaid Tariff Plan with the Authority on 09 June 2020, and it was analysed in the 2020/21 FY Q2 Bi-Annual Tariff Analysis Report³⁰. The amendments to the Cell C Prepaid Tariff Plan entailed a reduction of the validity period from 7 days to 3 days and data allocation of certain bundles, the increase of the maximum recharge value by

The largest increase on the Cell C eMoyeni Prepaid Bundles in percentage terms of 117.5% occurred on the Local 10 SMS Bundles. The largest price reduction on the Cell C eMoyeni Prepaid Bundles in absolute and percentage terms is R 69.56 or 40% and it occurred in the 2GB data bundle. The Cell C eMoyeni Prepaid Tariff Plan can be compared to the Cell C Shoprite K'nect Mobile Prepaid Tariff Plan as in table 36 below.

Cell C eMoyeni Prepaid Tariff Plan customers face lower (1% less) prices for data and Local SMS (1.2% less) than Shoprite K'nect Mobile Prepaid Tariff Plan customers. Customers on the Cell C eMoyeni Prepaid Tariff Plan are negatively affected by higher rates for voice calls and local SMSes compared to customers on the Cell C Shoprite K'nect Mobile Prepaid Tariff Plan.

The amendments of the Cell C eMoyeni Data Bundles became effective on 21 September 2021.

2.5.2. Promotional Prepaid Integrated Plans

2.5.2.1. Cell C All-in-One Bundle Double Data Promotion

Cell C filed amendments of its All-in-One Bundle Double Data Promotion on 21 July and 20 August 2021 with the Authority. The amendments entailed the reduction of the validity period of the All-in-One 300MB Bundle, the introduction a new integrated All-in-One 450MB Bundle priced at R 50 and the changing of bonus anytime data to be allocated only at night as bonus "Nite" data during the

promotion period. Table 37 below details the amendment of the All-in-One 300MB Bundle and the new 450MB Bundle.

The Telkom Varsity Vibe 2GB priced at R 39 can be compared to the MTN's Work From Home/Study Bundles 2GB priced at R 99, which is 153.8% more, however worth noting is that MTN's Home/Study bundles are valid for 30 days, which means customers are probably paying more due to the longer (16 days more) validity period. The Telkom Varsity Vibe was launched in the market on 01 December 2021, and it will be available for a period of 6 months.

2.6. LTE and Wi-Fi Tariff Plans

This section analyses LTE and wireless Internet tariff plans offered in the market as per notifications filed from 01 July to 31 December 2021. The analysis of the tariff plans will consider month-to-month (MtM)³² plans applicable offered during the period under review.

2.6.1.MTN BozzaGigs 2GB + 2GB

On 08 July 2021, MTN added a new BozzaGigs 2GB + 2GB data bundle in its BozzaGigs LTE Price Plan that was initially filed on 16 April 2021 and analysed in the 2021/22 FY Q2 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report³³. The new BozzaGigs 2GB + 2GB entails 2GB standard data and 2GB Night Express data, valid for 14 days at a price of R 49. MTN introduced the bundle in the market on 20 July 2021.

2.6.2.Cell C Home Connecta-Flexi Promotion

Cell C filed an amendment to its Home Connecta-Flexi Promotion with the Authority on 05 August 2021. The amendment was in regard to the terms and conditions of the plan, wherein the period of the night (or "nite", as referred by Cell C) data allocation of the plan was revised, and it was made available from 00:00 to 04:59:59 am, it was previously from 00:00 to 05:59:59 am.

The reduction of the night data period by an hour has a negative affect for customers as they now have less time to enjoy this night data benefit. The amendment of the Cell C Home Connecta-Flexi Promotion became effective on 18 August 2021.

2.6.3. Cell C Home Connecta

Cell C filed an amendment to its Home Connecta with the Authority on 05 August 2021. The amendment was in regard to the terms and conditions of the plan, wherein the period of the night (or "nite", as referred by Cell C) data allocation of the plan was revised, and it was made available from 00:00 to 04:59:59 am, it was previously from 00:00 to 05:59:59 am.

The reduction of the night data period by an hour has a negative affect for customers as they now have less time to enjoy this night data benefit. The amendment became effective on 18 August 2021.

It should be noted that the MtM contracts are SIM-only contracts, while the 24-month contracts are device inclusive. As shown in the table above, the packages are subject to a fair usage policy (FUP). For example, the speed on the MyMTN Home Uncapped FLTE 20Mbps package will be throttled to a maximum of 4Mbps when data usage exceeds 600GB at a given month.

MTN's price plan is more competitive when compared to Vodacom's Home Internet Service (filed on 30 August 2020). For example, MTN offers its MyMTN Home Uncapped FLTE 10Mbps for R 599, whereas Vodacom offers capped 200GB (100GB Anytime data + 100GB Night Owl data) for the same monetary value.

MTN's introduced its MyMTN Home Uncapped FLTE price plan in the market on 23 September 2021.

2.6.7. Telkom LTE Prepaid Data Bundles

Telkom Mobile's amendment to its LTE Prepaid Data Bundles was filed with the Authority on 21 September 2021 and entailed the introduction of the new 3GB + 3GB bundle and the increasing of the inclusive data on the 31-day 5GB + 5GB LTE Prepaid data to 7.5GB + 7.5GB. As shown in the table above, the packages are uncapped, however, they are subject to FUP, which means that they are throttled after exceeding the FUP threshold. For example, 10Mbps 400GB package offered for R 599 on a 24-month contract is throttled to Internet speeds up to 2Mbps after surpassing 400GB of data usage. Vodacom's Home Internet Uncapped Service can be compared to MTN's MyMTN Home Uncapped FLTE price plan. For example, both operators offer

their 10Mbps 400GB packages for R 599. However, MTN does offer a SIM-only month-to-month 10Mbps 400GB package for R 499.

Vodacom introduced the new Home Internet packages in the market on 22 November 2021.

The table above shows that some customers incurred higher subscription costs, for example the largest price increase in percentage terms of 13.7% occurred on the Vox Telecom 10/10Mbps FTTH package, which is now priced the same as the Vox Telecom 20/20Mbps FTTH package at R 630, which means customers would be better off selecting the 20/20Mbps FTTH package. Conversely some customers incurred lower subscription costs, for example the largest price decrease in percentage terms of 21.1% occurred on the Vox Telecom 100/100Mbps FTTH package. The Vox Telecom 20/20Mbps FTTH package priced at R 630 can be compared to the Cipherwave Zoom Fibre 20/20Mbps analysed in the 2021/22 FY Q2 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report³⁵ priced at R 688 or R 58 (9.2%) more. The amendments of the Vox Telecom FTTH became effective on 01 August and 01 December 2021, respectively.

2.7.1.3. MWEB FTTH

MWEB filed an amendment to its FTTH packages with the Authority on 19 October 2021. The amendment entailed a price reduction of the 20/10Mbps package. Table 52 below sets out the change in tariffs on MWEB FTTH.

2.7.2.13. MWEB on Openserve FTTH

MWEB filed new FTTH product on its Openserve network with the Authority on 20 and 27 August 2021, wherein it introduced an uncapped 500/250Mbps line speed package priced at R 1 279 per month. The MWEB on Openserve 500/250Mbps can be compared with the Cybersmart Openserve Lite Fibre 500/250Mbps priced at R 1 299 or 1.6% more. The MWEB on Openserve 500/250Mbps FTTH package was launched in the market on 31 August 2021. MWEB also introduced a 25/25Mbps FTTH package on 20 August 2021 priced at R 399.

In addition, MWEB filed its FTTH on the Openserve network with the Authority on 10 September 2021. The two package MWEB FTTH offering is part of a Proof-of-Concept (POC) service which is offered in select suburbs with the Openserve network. Table 70 below sets out the details of the MWEB on Openserve FTTH plan.

2.7.2.14. Cybersmart Openserve Lite Fibre

Cybersmart filed a new FTTH product on its Openserve network with the Authority on 26 August 2021, wherein it introduced a 500/250Mbps line speed package priced at R 1 299 per month.

Cybersmart's Openserve Lite Fibre 500/250Mbps can be compared with the MWEB on Openserve 500/250Mbps priced at R 1 279 or 1.5% less. The Cybersmart Openserve Lite Fibre was launched was on 10 September 2021.

2.7.2.15. Cell C C-Fibre Vumatel Village Tariff Plan

Cell C filed an amendment of its C-Fibre Vumatel Village Tariff Plan with the Authority on 31 August 2021. The Cell C Vumatel Village Tariff Plan was originally filed with the Authority on 27 August 2020 and analysed in the 2020/21 FY Q4 Biannual Report³⁷. The amendment entailed line speed upgrades and price reductions. Table 71 below sets out the line speed upgrades and price reductions on the Cell C C-Fibre Vumatel Village Tariff Plan.

The largest price reduction in percentage terms of 14% occurred on the C-Fibre 20/2Mbps package. The Cell C C-Fibre Vumatel Village 100/100Mbps can be compared with the Directel on Vumatel Apollo 100/100³⁸ priced at R 1 045 or 4.9% less. The amendment of the Cell C C-Fibre Vumatel Village Tariff Plan became effective on 01 October 2021.

The price reductions and the introduction of new packages positively impacted customers who experienced a reduction in the cost to communicate and an increase in the options available in the fibre market. The Telkom on Frogfoot Unlimited Home 50/50Mbps can be compared to the MWEB on Frogfoot 50/50Mbps³⁹ priced at R 699 or 17.7% less. The amendments of the Telkom FTTH plan became effective on 20 September 2021.

The largest price decrease in absolute value and percentage terms of R 250 or 20.8% occurred on the Amobia on Century City/Oasis 100/50Mbps. The Amobia on Century City/Oasis 20/10Mbps priced at R 635 is comparable to the MWEB on Century City Connect Uncapped 20/10Mbps priced at R 639 or 0.6% more. The amendment on the Amobia on Century City/Oasis FTTH plan became effective on 01 December 2021.

2.7.2.23. Amobia on Buh-Rein FTTH

Amobia filed an amendment to its FTTH packages on the Buh-Rein network with the Authority on 18 November 2021. The amendments entailed an upgrade of line speeds, a decrease in prices, the termination and introduction of certain fibre packages on the Amobia on Buh-Rein FTTH plan. Customers benefit from the doubling of line speed on the Amobia on Buh-Rein FTTH package from 15/7Mbps to 30/15Mbps, although it was accompanied by a price increase of 13.5%. The remaining packages on Amobia on Buh-Rein FTTH remained unchanged. The amendment of the Amobia on Buh-Rein FTTH plan became effective on 01 December 2021.

2.7.2.24. MWEB on Lightstruck FTTH

The largest increase on the MWEB on Lightstruck FTTH plan in percentage terms of 4.8% occurred on the Uncapped 100/100Mbps package. The MWEB on Lightstruck FTTH 50/50Mbps package priced at R 929 can be compared to the Cybersmart on Lightstruck Uncapped Fibre 50/50Mbps analysed in the 2020/21 FY Q4 Bi-annual Tariff Analysis Report⁴¹ priced at R 829, which is R 100 (or 10.8%) less. The amendment of the MWEB on Lightstruck FTTH plan became effective on 01 December 2021.

2.7.3. Promotional FTTH Plans

2.7.3.1. Telkom 500Mbps Home Unlimited Premium Promotion

Telkom filed the 500Mbps Home Unlimited Premium Promotion with the Authority on 24 November 2021. The Telkom 500Mbps Home Unlimited Premium Promotion will be available for 6 months and will allow Telkom customers on the 200Mbps Home Unlimited Premium to upgrade to the 500Mbps Home Unlimited Premium at the same price as the 200Mbps. Table 81 below details the two Telkom 200Mbps and 500Mbps packages.

2.7.4. Comparative Analysis of Fibre Products

This sub-section provides a comparative analysis of FTTH packages provided on 3rd party FNOs. It aims to show how different ISPs price their packages of the same line speeds and shows the average market price, based on ICASA's tariff notifications database, which is formulated from information received from tariff notifications.

2.7.4.1. 20/20Mbps FTTH on Various Networks




Figure 6: 20/20Mbps Packages offered by 3rd party FNOs on Various Network





Figure 7: Percentage Deviation from the 20/20Mbps Average Price

- Figure 6 above shows that the average price of the sampled 20/20Mbps line speeds is approximately priced at R 777 per month, while figure 7 shows the percentage deviation of the various 20/20Mbps packages from the average price.
- Cybersmart's 20/20Mbps on Vodacom has the highest subscription fee of R 1 139, which is 47 % more than the average price.
- Cybersmart's 20/20Mbps in the Big Bay MPOA residential area has the lowest subscription fee of R 399, which is49% less than the average price.
- Vodacom's 20/20Mbps on Openserve is also reasonably priced at R 449, which is 42% lower than the average price.

2.7.4.2. 25/25Mbps FTTH on Various Networks

Figure 8: 25/25Mbps Packages offered by 3rd party FNOs on Various Networks







Figure 9: Percentage Deviation from the 25/25Mbps Average Price

- The sample approximates that the average subscription fee of the 25/25Mbps line speed at R 651, as shown in figure 8 above.
- In terms of standard plans, Cybersmart's 25/25Mbps FTTH on the Openserve network has the lowest subscription fee of R 498 which translates to the largest below average price deviation of 24%.
- MWEB's 25/25Mbps FTTH (Lite) on MetroFibre's network has the highest subscription fee of R 829, which translates to the largest deviation above the average price of 27%.

• It is worth noting that 6 out of 15, of the 25/25Mbps FTTH plans offered by the 3rd party FNOs in the sample charge prices which are below the average price, with 2 being more than 10% lower.

2.7.4.3. 50/50Mbps FTTH on Various Networks

Figure 10: 50/50Mbps Packages offered on Various Fibre Networks







Figure 11: Percentage Deviation from the 50/50Mbps Average Price

- The sample approximates the average subscription fee of the 50/50Mbps line speed at R 872 per month, as shown on figure 10.
- The cheapest price for 50/50Mbps FTTH on the Frogfoot network is MWEB's priced at R 699, which is 19.8% below the estimated average price.
- Cell C's 50/50Mbps FTTH on Vumatel's network has the highest subscription fee of R 1 099 which translates to the largest deviation of 26.1% above the average price.
- Figure 11 above shows that 8 out of 23 operators providing fibre services charge above the average price.

2.7.4.4. 100/100Mbps FTTH on Various Networks

Figure 12: 100/100Mbps Packages offered by 3rd party FNOs on Various Networks






Figure 13: Percentage Deviation from the 100/100Mbps Average Price

- The sample approximates the average subscription fee of the 100/100Mbps line speed at R 1 092 per month.
- MTN's 100/100Mbps FTTH on Vodacom's network has the highest subscription fee of R 1 499 which translates to the largest deviation from the average price of 37% more.
- Cell C has the lowest subscription fee on its 100/100Mbps package on the Frogfoot network at R 929, which is 15% less than the average price.
- It is worth noting that most (i.e., 11 out of 20) of the 100/100Mbps FTTH packages offered by 3rd party FNOs shown in the sample charge below the average price.

3. Conclusion

The Authority observed increased competitiveness between licensees in terms of the number of promotions that were offered in the market, during the period under review. The promotional offers increased by 49 notifications from preceding reporting period, from 24 to 73 new promotions launched. The Authority also received 26 extensions of existing promotions. The increased number of promotional offers is seen as a strategic tool to incentivise, reward (loyal customers), attract new customers and to alleviate the financial burden brought by the pandemic by providing more affordable access to digital services. The extensions and/or amendments of previous promotions could also be an indication of customers' positive reaction towards promotional offers.

The Authority continues to observe data price reductions with various amendments filed by licensees. In the period under review, all four major MNOs reduced the prices of their respective 30-day standard prepaid data bundles. For example, Cell C reduced the price of its 1GB data bundle by 10.5% from R 95 to R 85. The 10.5% price reduction of Cell C's 1GB data bundle has positively contributed to a reduced average price of the 1GB data bundle which is currently at R 83.50, however it should be noted that Telkom Mobile offers the most affordable 30-day standard prepaid 1GB data bundle priced at R 79. Vodacom's price reduction of the 2GB data bundle from R 159 to R 149 resulted in an average price of R 147 on the 30-day standard prepaid 2GB data bundle. Other positive amendments in the data services market include the reintroduction of Cell C's 500MB data bundle priced at R 45, making it the most affordable 30-day standard prepaid 500MB data bundle currently offered in the market.

The Authority received eight notifications from various licensees regarding voice bundles. For example, on 29 September 2021, MTN filed its new Bozza Talk Bundles wherein it offers customers personalised voice bundles with effective rates ranging from R 0.01 to R 0.08 per minute. Therefore, customers on the MTN Ska Wara Bundle Bonanza price plan, for example, can save at least R 0.91 per minute on call when purchasing the personalised Bozza Talk Bundles as opposed to using OOB rates which charges a flat-rate of R 0.99 per minute. Faced with increased

usage of Internet services, this is viewed by the Authority as an indication of the operator's efforts to increase the utilisation of voice services by customers. On the other hand, Cell C increased the flat rates on the MegaBonus and UltraBonus tariff plans from R 1.72 and R 2, both to R 2.50 per minute, respectively. The increase in Cell C's voice rates is concerning given the Authority's efforts to reduce costs to communicate through various initiatives including reduced call termination rates.

The Authority also observed an increase in the provision of LTE and Wireless Internet services, the introduction of 5G products and wireless fibre Internet. For instance, MTN introduced new MyMTN Home Uncapped F-LTE and MyMTN Home Uncapped 5G price plans in the market, wherein it offers high speed wireless Internet services. For example, the MyMTN Home Uncapped F-LTE 20Mbps is offered to customers for R 699 on a MtM basis, subject to 600GB FUP. The wireless Internet services serve as an alternative to fixed broadband services, especially in areas where there is no fibre footprint.

FNOs and ISPs continue to introduce new and/or amend previous fibre services in the market which the Authority perceives as beneficial to the public in terms of increased product choice and may ultimately result in competitive pricing. For example, Vodacom amended its fibre plan, wherein it decreased the prices of selected fibre packages. For example, Vodacom's 50/50Mbps fibre package on the MetroFibre network realised a R 208.76 or 20.7% tariff decrease from R 1 007.76 to R 799. It should be noted that the Authority received a total of 79 notifications regarding fibre services (up from 50 in the preceding reporting period) from various FNOs in the period under review. The FTTH comparative analysis shows that the average prices for the 20/20Mbps, 25/25Mbps, 50/50Mbps and 100/100Mbps are approximately, R 777, R 636, R 872 and R 1 092, respectively.

The Authority will continue to monitor and publish this report with retail market prices to ensure that subscribers have information on the competitive rates which are prevailing in the market.
