- the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act, No. 53 of 2003),
- Promotion to Access of Information Act, 2 of 2000, Protection of Personal Information

Bid Threshold

THE BID WILL BE BASED ON 80/20 PRINCIPLE AS PER REGULATION 6 AND 7 OF THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS 2022.

- 80 Points for price
- 20 points for PPPFA (Specific Goals)



Response format

- SBD 3.1 (Pricing schedule) Pricing must be inclusive of all applicable taxes (e.g. VAT), price proposal must include SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS.
- SBD 4 (Declaration of Interest)
- SDB 6.1 (Preference Points claim form)
- SBD 8 (Declaration of bidder's past Supply Chain Management practices)

SBD 9 – (Certification of Independent Bid Determination and Declaration of fronting)



Reasons for disqualification

ICASA reserves the right to disqualify any bidders who do not comply with one or more of the following bid requirements, and such disqualification may take place without prior notice to the offending bidder:

- Bidders who did not make submission as per required(Soft copy is mandatory).
- Bidders who submitted information that is fraudulent, factually untrue or inaccurate, for example memberships that do not exist, BBBEE credentials, experience, etc.;
- Bidders who do not meet the cut-off mark on the pre-qualification criteria as stipulated in this RFB. (70 points)
- Bidders who have been blacklisted as per the National Treasury database.
- Bidders who do not comply with the special conditions or any other condition set out in the bid document.
- Late bids. a) A bid will not be considered if it arrives a second after 11h00 or any time thereafter. Bids arriving late will not be considered under any circumstances. b) Bidders are therefore strongly advised to ensure that bids are dispatched allowing sufficient time for any unforeseen events that may delay the delivery of the bid.
