	<ul> <li>In accordance with this Act, bidders are required to submit original and valid BBBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their BBBEE rating claims.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The 10 points claimed for BBBEE Level will be split in accordance with the SBD 6.1 documents as per the evaluation criteria.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Bidders who do not submit BBBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or are non-compliant contributors to BBBEE do not qualify for preference points for BBBBEE but should not be disqualified from the bidding process. They will score points out of 90 for price only and zero (0) points out 10 for BBBEE</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Bidders should submit certified copies of BBBEE or alternatively submit an original BBBEE certificate per bid</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>EME – Exempted Micro Enterprise AND QSE MUST submit original or certified copy of sworn affidavit not <u>a</u>copy of copy</li> </ul>
F	Required Documentation:
	<ul> <li>One Original Copy of Technical and Pricing submission</li> <li>Three copies of each submission</li> <li>One USB with two folders, one folder for technical response and one for pricing</li> <li>ID documents of Directors (Certified)</li> <li>Company registration documents</li> <li>Company profile</li> <li>Tax compliant</li> <li>Certified Copy of BBBEE Certificate or sworn affidavit original or certified copy for EME and QSE not copy of copy</li> </ul>
F	Reasons for Disqualification:
	<ul> <li>Bidders who submit incomplete information and documentation as per the requirements of this RFB.</li> <li>Bidders who submit uncontactable references</li> <li>Bidders who are not registered on the Central Supplier Database</li> </ul>

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- Bidders who submitted information that is fraudulent, factually untrue or inaccurate, for example memberships that do not exist, BBBEE credentials, experience, etc.
  - Mandatory requirements are applicable before commencement to functionality
  - Bidders who do not meet the cut-off mark (70 P0INTS) on functional/technical requirements as stipulated in this RFB.
- Bidders who do not provide the required number of bid responses <u>i.e.i.e.</u>, one (1) original hard copy, three (3) hard copies and one (1) electronic copy (on USB) in PDF format.
- Bidders that submit un-bound tender documents
- Bidders who have been blacklisted as per the National treasury database.
- Bidders who do not comply with the special conditions or any other condition set out in the bid document
