Accordingly, the CCC recommended to the Authority that the following order be issued to the Respondent:</p> <p>2.1.1 direct that the Licensee desist from any further contravention.</p> <p>2.1.2 direct the Licensee to pay a fine in the amount of R100,000. Half of this amount is suspended for a period of three years on condition that a finding of same non-compliance is not made against the Licensee during the period of suspension.</p> <p><u>Council Decision:</u></p> <p>2.2. Council resolved that paragraph 75.3 of the CCC recommendations, which provides for the payment of the R50,000 fine by means of instalments, should be removed. Council indicated that the request for a payment plan by the Respondent should only be entertained subsequent to the publishing of the finding.</p> <p>2.3.
