	On 13 February 2017, the Authority received applications from the applicant to transfer its I-ECS and I-ECNS licences to the transferee.	
	The applicants were using the Form G of the Process and Procedures Regulations for Individual licences published on 30 March 2016, in the Government Gazette No.3 9871 ("Processes and Procedures Regulations").

The purpose of the submission was to request Council to approve the transfer of an I-ECS and I-ECNS licences from Stream Broadband (Pty) Ltd ('the applicant') to Thobela Telecoms (RF) (Pty) Ltd ('the transferee").

On 18 July 2017, the Authority received applications from Stream Broadband (Pty) Ltd ('the applicant") to transfer its I-ECS and I-ECNS licences to Thobela Telecoms (RF) (Pty) Ltd ("the transferee").

- The applications were submitted using Form G of the Process **Procedures** and Regulations for Individual licences published on 30 March 2016 in the Government Gazette no.39871 ("Processes and Procedures Regulations").
- The applications were published for comment on 27 October 2017.
- No written representations were received by the closing date on 16 November 2017.

The licencing division was satisfied that the information submitted by applicant confirms that the meets minimum transferee the 30% requirement of equity held ownership by historically disadvantaged Individuals (HDIs).

## 2017/18 Q4: Northern Cape 3. Province Quality of Service Report.

The purpose of the memorandum was to request Council to approve the Quality of Service (QoS)

The 2017/18 Quarter 4 (Q4) Northern the report was approved.

Monitoring Report on measurements conducted during Q4 of 2017/18 in the Northern Cape Province for publication.

The Annual Performance Plan of Engineering and Technology sets out a target to conduct QoS monitoring quarterly. A snapshot drive tests in the following provinces was conducted;

- Limpopo, Mpumalanga,
  North West, Free State,
  Gauteng and Northern Cape.
- The Authority conducted measurements in the Province Northern Cape between 22 January 2018 05 February 2018, covering a total distance of over 2500 kilometres, targeting areas around Kuruman, Upington, Springbok, Kamiesberg and Calvinia.

The aim of the monitoring was to assess the QoS provided by the mobile operators as perceived by the users.

All mobile operators have committed themselves towards improving network quality in the affected areas through continuous network optimisation and future network infrastructure investments.
