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APPOINTMENT OF A CONSULTANT TO ASSIST THE INDEPENDENT COMMUNICATIONS AUTHORITY OF SOUTH AFRICA WITH THE LICENSING PROCESS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL MOBILE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SPECTRUM, INCLUDING CONDUCTING AN AUCTION PROCESS FOR THE LICENSING OF THE IMT750, IMT800, IMT1500, IMT2300, IMT3300, AND IMT3500 RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM BANDS

1. Background

- 1.1. The licensing process is availing spectrum resources on the following identified IMT spectrum bands: IMT750, IMT800, IMT1500, IMT2300, IMT3300, and IMT3500.
- 1.2. Radio Frequency Spectrum Assignment Plans for these IMT Spectrum bands were published in Government Gazette No. 47788 on 20 December 2022, and Government Gazette No 47763 was published on 19 December 2022.
- 1.3. Radio Frequency Spectrum Regulations published in Government Gazette Number 38641 (Notice 279 of 2015) dated 30 March 2015 ("RFSR 2015") as amended, prescribe the market-based approach to efficient spectrum management, which includes the use of an auction process for the licensing of the spectrum in respect of which demand exceeds supply.
- 1.4. The Authority is to appoint a service provider or consultant (Bidder) to assist with the auction design and management of the licensing process, including conducting an auction process for the assignment and licensing of the IMT spectrum bands IMT750, IMT800, IMT1500, IMT2300, IMT3300, and

IMT3500 spectrum bands as contemplated in terms of the Terms of Reference (TOR) contained in **Annexure A**.

- 1.5. The role of the Bidder is to assist the Authority with the formulation of the Invitation-to-Apply (ITA) preceded by a consultation process through an Information Memorandum, execution and implementation of the ITA, published in accordance with Regulations 6 and 7 of RFSR 2015.
- 1.6. Section 3 of the TOR provides the scope to be covered by the bidder.

2. Terms of Reference

2.1. The Terms of Reference are attached herewith as **Annexure A** and should be read in conjunction with the relevant regulations as published in the applicable Government Gazette Notices.

3. Period of Assignment

- 3.1. All work must be carried out by the schedule as agreed with the Authority.
- 3.2. The auction is aimed to be completed by March 2024. Preceding the Auction, the ITA must be published by September 2023, and the qualification stage be finalised by December 2023.

4. Briefing Session

4.1. Virtual Non-compulsory briefing session will be held after the publication of the tender. The Authority will confirm the briefing session's date and time.

5. Bid Advertisement and Bid Evaluation

5.1. The bid will be advertised for 21 working days on the e-Tender Portal and ICASA's website. The bid will be evaluated on an 80/20 procurement principle.

- 5.2. Bidders will be evaluated on:
 - 5.2.1. Receiving of Bids and Compliance Checks.
 - 5.2.2. Functionality; and
 - 5.2.3. Price and preferential points.
- 5.3. Only bidders who meet the cut-off score of 80 points out of 100 points for functionality will be considered further for price evaluation. All bid proposals submitted will be evaluated per the 80/20 procurement principle prescribed by National Treasury Regulations.
- 5.4. Bids will be evaluated for functionality in line with the following criteria:
