Subject: Community Service (Grade 12 Mathematics and Physical Sciences lessons broadcast)

Introduction.

The objective of this proposal is to offer a service to the community in terms of broadcasting on radio specifically Mathematics and Physical Sciences lessons.

Numerous learners in East London and the surrounding areas are disadvantaged by the scarcity of experienced seasonal Science and Mathematics educators. Many families have access to radio that can be used as a tool to improve the knowledge base of the learners in these subjects hence improving the matric pass rate.

Justification of the teaching programme.

1. Most of the learners in the East London townships especially are in schools which lack human resource in Mathematics and Science.
2. A good percentage of households in East London possess a radio, the lesson broadcasts will assist the learners in disadvantaged schools to equally access quality teaching in mathematics and science.
3. Izwilethemba FM has got a huge audience in East London and this will enable MGN College to assist a relatively bigger proportion of learners in need.
4. Currently, the existing situation of the Corona Virus disease has forced big schools to introduce shifts which have greatly impacted on the teaching and learning process negatively, hence a need for intervention.

Benefits and target group.

There is a steady growth in the population of East London implying that there is an equally steady increase in the number of learners hence need for more education programmes to assist in satisfying the educational needs of the community.

The programme will

1. Target learners from disadvantaged schools that lack science and mathematics educators

2. Focus on bridging the gap that has been created by the effect of the Corona Virus pandemic, since the academic years 2020 and 2021 were trimmed which affected the curriculum coverage.
3. Concentrate on an approach that will better prepare the learners for the final exams.
4. Assist in promoting mathematics and science to attract more learners to the subjects.

Sustainability of the programme

Since this is a form of community service, MGN College will use its two science and mathematics educators together with another employee at the college who has experience in Radio presentation.

The transport and all other costs related to the presenters will be met by MGN College. We can afford to stage the programme in the evenings any time from 7:00pm to 10:00pm as it is the suitable time for learners.

We have got experience in radio lesson presentation as two of the intended staff members were involved in it 2019/2020.

Good day BCMM Community and all surrounding areas. I am [REDACTED] working as a Recruitment Officer at Synergy Biomed Research Institute (SBRI). We are a Clinical research organization based in no. 280 Oxford street East London. The organization specializes in clinical trials for HIV prevention & COVID 19 vaccines. The site is currently conducting trials on a COVID19 vaccine called Moderna.

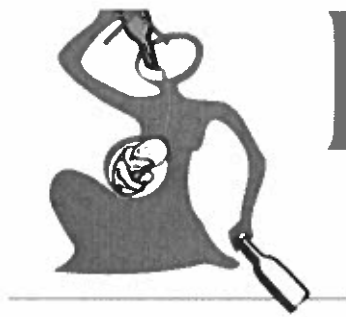
This vaccine has been effective in its use in the US and many European Union (EU) countries with an efficacy of over 90%. The vaccine is safe and works in preventing severe Covid 19 complications, as shown in the data provided by the above mentioned countries. This vaccine has not been used in Sub Saharan Africa as this region has a prevalence of the Delta strain of the virus which was not present during the time the vaccine was tested in US and EU. The study wants to collect data on the level of protection people living in Sub-Saharan Africa will receive from the vaccine, as compared to US and EU citizens. It is for this reason that the institution is recruiting HIV infected participants who are at high risk of Covid infection based on their medical condition – we want to see if the vaccine will offer them adequate protection.

- Participants are volunteers who agree to participate in the study. They go through an informed consent process before they take part in the study. This is where everything gets explained to them thoroughly so they can make that informed decision.

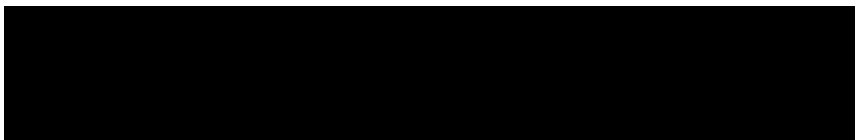
