- **IH** appreciated Mariza's contribution it proves that she has read the report.
- **PD** comment was that she read the report issues were well captured and wished it was escalated down to Regions there are issues which requires urgent attention from the Regions.
- ZA- indicated that the report was more in depth than other reports that we have put together. First one, just seeing if we can somehow maybe create new avenues within ourselves to go under that support, secondly in areas where there is completely no connectivity like weights known. There was overlap between Department of Education and ICASA's mandate with giving or ensuring that connectivity for the underprivileged and for children living with these abilities in special schools. Even the Department of Health is unable to update its records.
- IH-indicated that PD point its relevant how we phrase our reporting to emphasise our action, how CAP Members prepared it.
