APPLICATIONS FOR A TRANSFER OF INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE AND INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK SERVICE LICENCES FROM DATA MOBILITY TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS (PTY) LTD TO NEW WORLD ORDER MEDIA (PTY) LTD

1. Data Mobility Technology Solutions (Pty) Ltd shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the transfer applications, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within forty-two (42) working days from the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette. Data Mobility Technology Solutions (Pty) Ltd must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, OR has sent a copy of such response by registered mail OR by facsimile OR by e-mail to the relevant person having made such written representations.
