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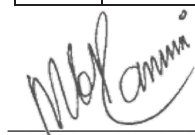

COMMUNITY SOUND BROADCASTING SERVICE AND RADIO FREQUENCY
SPECTRUM LICENCES**

1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has completed Phase 2 of its Invitation to Pre-Register ("ITP-R") for Community Sound Broadcasting Service and Radio Frequency Spectrum licences process as published in Government Gazette no. 51727 on 10 December 2024.
2. Out of the forty-one (41) applications that were admitted to Phase 1 of the licensing process, nineteen (19) applicants complied with the pre-registration requirements and were therefore admitted to Phase 2 of the licensing process. The second phase of the licensing process was undertaken in terms of section 17 of the Electronic Communications Act No. 36 of 2005, as amended.
3. Following completion of the process, a total of eighteen (18) applicants were granted licences, while one (1) applicant, Mielie FM NPC t/a MLI FM, was not granted a licence due to failure to submit Form B in Phase 2 as required by the ITP-R.

4. The Authority advises that the following successful applicants were issued and granted CSBS and RFS licences:
