CCC Matter

SABC v SoS and MMA – Case no: 287/2018 – It was alleged that SABC 3 had contravened regulation 5.9 of the ICASA Advertising, Infomercials and Sponsorship Regulations – SABC 3 had not disclosed that a Minister's participation in a broadcast was undertaken to be paid for. The SABC conceded its error and has taken steps to ensure that no repetition takes place, the CCC has come to the conclusion that it would not be fitting to order a fine.

BCCSA Matters

Adjudication No: 015/A/2017- Diale: Isidingo SABC 3 - Disruption of privacy consequent to broadcast of private mobile phone number in an episode of a popular soap opera. The contravention of the code entails that an individual's right to privacy was infringed. As sanction the broadcaster is reprimanded and requested to broadcast a correction within three days after receiving this adjudication.

JUDGEMENTS

Case No: 01/2009. F vs SABC3 - Defamation — News programmes on SABC conducting investigation as to whether person had sexually molested children — programmes identifying person as an alleged offender, but nevertheless referring to his identification as an exposé of the person and broadcasting evidence by children of his deeds — use of "alleged" and attempt at getting his view in an interview not a defence to complaint of defamation. A fine was imposed.

Case No: 03/2009, Foundation for Equality before the Law vs SABC3 - Complaint that programme commemorating tenth anniversary of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission created a one-sided impression that the officers of the security forces were the only ones who committed atrocities during the armed struggle and that the officers attempted to prevent the victims of such atrocities from giving evidence against them during the TRC hearings — Tribunal finding that there was not sufficient balance in presenting the programme that dealt with controversial issues of public importance — contravention of clause 36 of the Code of Conduct found and reprimand imposed.

Case No: 12/2009, AfriForum vs SABC 3 News (Special Assignment) - Complaint that the Respondent, by using the term Tshwane in its news broadcasts, was treating Pretoria unequally and unfairly in comparison to other cities in South Africa, and was therefore reporting news unfairly — Tribunal finding that "Tshwane" has not been registered as a place name on the Official Database of the South African Geographical Names System (SAGNS), that no legal basis exists upon which the city may be referred to as Tshwane, and that reference to other places in South Africa by city name rather than municipal name, while referring to Pretoria by municipal name only, constituted unequal and therefore unfair treatment of Pretoria and amounted to a contravention of clauses 34.1 and 34.3 of the Code — while deviating from the decision in case number 30/2005, this decision nevertheless constitutes new ground s on which the Respondent's broadcasts were challenged—complaint upheld but no sanction imposed.

Case No: 32/2011, Mail & Guardian Media Limited Sole v SABC3 - News — unfair treatment of newspaper and journalist by SABC3 in not having granted a newspaper and its journalist a fair opportunity to reply to accusations of bribery and racial bias. Complaint upheld. SABC3 directed to

report summary of judgment. News – Complainants' case stated in separate opportunity to reply fairly granted by SAFM.

Case No: 40/2012, Marais vs SABC3 - Error of fact – agreed to be corrected by way of interview with representative of relevant society.

Case No: 58/2012, Hartzenberg & Others vs SABC3 - Religion – misconception of the meaning of the Eucharist within the Christian religion – contravention of Code.

Case No: 14/2013, Pillay vs SABC3, Children – parental guidance incorrectly advised for film which should have been a 135 film. Reprimand issued.

Case No: 31/2013, Universal Church of the Kingdom of God in South Africa vs SABC3 - Defamation – implied by inclusion of visuals of Complainant's buildings in programme dealing with alleged crime. Findings to be broadcast.

Case No: 35/2013, Christ Embassy Church vs SABC3 - Right to reply - conceded and settled. The matter was settled and the complainant was granted an opportunity to rectify the matter on air.

Case No: 45/2013, Mohammedi vs SABC3 - News — not acceptable to refer to "Islamist militants" unless solid factual justification for such a reference exists — Mohammedi vs SABC3. The complaint was upheld. No sanction was, however, imposed since the SABC apologised for the error, took disciplinary steps, and undertook to ensure that there would be no repetition of the error.

Case No: 02/2014, Forbes vs SABC3 - Competition — rules did not initially disclose that only clients of a certain bank were permitted to take part — serious contravention — fine imposed.

Case No: 03/2017, Daile vs SABC3, - An appeal against BCCSA adjudication No: 01/A/2017 - sanction of a reprimand imposed for a contravention of clause 15(1) on privacy: Appeal dismissed a fine of R10 000.

Case No: 10/2019 - FIRSTRAND FINANCE COMPANY LIMITED vs SABC3, -Broadcaster failed to provide right to reply. Clause (12) (1) & (2) and 13(1) & (2) of the Code contravened.

Adjudication No: 29/A/2022, Silson vs SABC3 — A complaint concerning an episode of Survivor's Remorse broadcast before the watershed during which offensive language was used. The complaint was upheld. Reprimanded.

- 4.2 The licensed service shall provide mix of informative, educational and entertaining material.

5. Training and skills development obligations

- 5.1 The Licensee must adopt and implement equal opportunity employment practices.
- 5.2 The Licensee must ensure that its management and staff are representative of South African society and that its human resource policies take into account the development of managerial, production, technical and other skills and expertise, particularly with regard to the historically disadvantaged persons.
- 5.3 The licensee shall endeavour to achieve fair and reasonable participation by historically disadvantaged persons with respect to:
 - (a) its management and control structures;
 - (b) skills development;

3. Local content obligations

In each licence year, the Licensee shall, within 30 days of end of the quarter, submit to the Authority written records indicating the extent of:

- (1) the different genres;
- (2) the South African Television Content,
- (3) the use of each official languages,

in programme material broadcast on the licensed service during that quarter, in each instance, distinguishing between genres, providing the relevant details in relation to prime time and the South African television broadcast period and expressing the relevant details both as an aggregate in minutes and as a percentage of the total of all such programming material.



4. Programming obligations

4.1 General:

- 4.1.1. To the extent that the Licensee provides programming of a religious nature, it shall ensure that such programming adequately reflects the diversity of South Africa's religions.
- 4.1.2 The Licensee shall take reasonable steps to provide a wide range of programming in the official languages of the Republic; and provide programming that reflects both the unity and the diverse cultural and multi-lingual nature of the Republic and all of its cultures and regions to audiences.
- 4.2 The Licensee shall, during the South African television performance period, provide programme material that caters and has due regard for the interests of all sectors of South African society and shall provide programming on and relevant to health related issues; gender issues; and all age groups.
- 4.3 The Licensee shall ensure that reasonable provision is made for sign language translation to be provided during news bulletins transmitted in prime time and during other programme genres broadcasting throughout the day.

4.4 Programme Content per Genre:

The Licensee shall, in each financial year set out below, broadcast at least the following number of hours of programme material in the following genres during the South African television performance period:

4.5 <u>Measurements and repeat broadcasts:</u>

The Licensee's compliance with the programming requirements set out in sub-clause (2) above shall be measured as a weekly average over a period of one year, provided that repeat broadcasts of programme material shall count towards the Licensee's compliance with the above-mentioned requirements and provided further that repeat broadcasts of South African television content will continue to be governed by the television content regulations.

4.6 Events of National Interest:

- 4.6.1 The Authority may, on written application by the Licensee, grant the Licensee exemption in writing, on such terms and conditions as the Authority deems necessary in the circumstances, from compliance with some or all of the programming obligations set out in this Licence, for a specified period, in the event that the Licensee satisfies the Authority that it is unable to comply with such obligations as a result of the broadcast of any event of national interest.
- 4.6.2 The Licensee's written application for exemption contemplated in subclause 4.6.1 above, must be submitted to the Authority before the commencement of the broadcast of the relevant event of national interest, provided that, in exceptional circumstances, the Authority will accept and consider an application for such exemption after the commencement of such broadcast, provided further that the application is submitted to the Authority as soon as is reasonably practicable after such commencement.

- 4.6.3 The Licensee's written application for exemption contemplated in subclause 4.6.1 above must specify:
 - (i) the nature of the event of national interest concerned;
 - (ii) the likely duration of the broadcast; and
 - (iii) the basis on which the Licensee contends that the event is of national interest and that it will be unable to comply with some or all of its programming obligations if the broadcast were to take place.

4.7 News and Current Affairs:

The licensee shall in the production of its news and current affairs programming:

- (a) exercise full editorial control in respect of the contents of such programming;
- (b) include matters of international, national, regional and where appropriate, local significance;
- (c) meet the highest standards of journalistic professionalism;
- (d) provide fair, unbiased, impartial and balanced coverage independent from governmental, commercial or other interference; and
- (e) provide a reasonable opportunity for the public to receive a variety of points of view on matters of public concern.

4.8 Programming targeted at Children:

In the production and presentation of its children's programming, the Licensee shall ensure that such children's programming is:

- (a) broadcast at times of the day when children are available to watch;
- (b) targeted at and appropriate for children between the ages of nought (0) to six (6) years and seven (7) to twelve (12) years respectively; and
- (c) educational and is made from children's point of view.
- 5. Limitations on Advertising and Provision of advertising-related Information:
 - 5.1 The Licensee may not:



- 5.1.1. broadcast more than an average of ten (10) minutes of advertisements per hour on the licensed service during any licence year; and
- 5.1.2 broadcast advertisements in excess of twelve (12) minutes in any one hour.
- 5.2 The Licensee shall, within 30 days of the end of each quarter, submit to the Authority written records indicating the extent of advertisements broadcast on the licensed service during that quarter, including:
- 5.2.1 the extent, expressed as a number of minutes, to which advertisements were broadcast in every hour during that quarter, and
- 5.2.2 the extent, expressed as an average number of minutes per hour, to which advertisements were broadcast during that quarter.

APPENDIX 9.1 OF FORM E

SABC submission with respect to licence conditions for the digital environment

1. Digital Licensing Framework

- The SABC's holds a long-standing view that there is a need to review the licensing model of the public broadcaster in order to enhance its delivery on the public service mandate in a multichannel digital environment. The current licensing model must be amended as it was designed for the analogue environment. It is submitted that the Authority should amend the SABC broadcasting licenses and impose collective television obligations rather than individual channel obligations.
- The SABC notes and supports the 2016 ICASA Local Content Position Paper and Regulation
 Findings Document which states that the 2016 Regulations will apply per bouquet but in practice the SABC still applies channel based targets or quotas.
- Essentially, global/collective quotas will allow flexibility in scheduling and assist the SABC to reposition the channels, incubate new channels and allow them space to grow on the DTT, DTH and OTT platforms. Individual channel quotas are rigid, lack programming flexibility across channels and do not enhance delivery of service in terms of audience needs. Furthermore, the channel based quotas may not be practical in instances where there are genre/niche channels, such as, Sport, Parliament, Education, Children, etc.
- As the SABC is experiencing financial challenges, it's advisable that it be allowed to self-regulate against the Broadcasting Act and Mandate of Educating, Informing and Entertaining.
 This will allow for the delivery against targets to expand across all VE services including OTT/DTT and DTH is present.

2. Must Carry and other regulatory requirements

- The Authority should consider the effectiveness of the regulations for feasible implementation in respect of the available recourse for parties in cases of deadlocks.
 Whether the existing provisions are fair and balanced to both parties.
- The Authority should review advertising regulations with the view to create fair competition between subscription television broadcasting services and Free to Air television services as the subscription TV services seem to unfairly benefit on both advertising and subscription. That is, the Authority should make a determination on whether the intention of section 60(4) of the Electronic Communications Act, has been achieved by the current regulations.

 Sport content carried on the channels should be counted as Mandate delivery and not displacement of Mandate on linear channels.

3. Local Content Quotas

- Keep the local content quota at a specific overall percentage and allow the channel to decide on how to deliver against it. Drop the Genre targets.
- Remove the Primetime specific delivery for local content as certain genre perform better
 outside of "primetime" and other content such as News is now consumed throughout the
 day by viewers.
- Provide a clear definition of what is Local content and allow the broadcaster to advise.
- Allow for local content repeats to count as 100% local content if it reaches audience targets –
 especially children, education and Drama and set an overall target for fresh content to be
 broadcast -20%.

4. Genre Quotas

- We need to revisit the defined Genres and not be too specific and so many hybrids and new
 types of genres have emerged, making it hard to respond to certain genre requirements as
 stipulated in the regulations. Allow channels to self-regulate and place proposed genre
 targets based on the current types of genres prevalent in the industry.
- The drama hours need to be looked at or reduced as our financial standing cannot keep up
 with the requirements and demand in that period as dramas are also expensive to acquire
 and to produce.
- Allow self-regulation for genre delivery with an overall target to be met for all mandated
 Genre such as children, Education and Religion
- News should not be placed within primetime as News is consumed at any time of the day and is currently accessible on digital platforms.

5. Primetime

- The relevance of Primetime for certain genre and also on digital needs to be revisited –
 different audiences are available at different times and viewing patterns due to digital
 content have changed.
- Primetime to be extended for linear Free to Air channels and dropped off for Sport content.
 Proposed time is 17:00 to 23:00

6. Language Quotas

- Allow for channels to self-regulate around the delivery of language.
- Provide clear measurements for language delivery so that channels delivery appropriately against set targets.
- Allow language delivery to be against the language and not link to regional representation.
- Provide clear regional representation quotas that are realistic, as not all provinces are content creation provinces and are equipped to deliver quality and commercially viable content.

7. Commercial

- Allow for all commercial models to be implored in Primetime have no limitations on commercial content in Primetime, AFPs, and Infomercials.
- PBS is more profitable than PCS, the division is artificial, drop this and allow for the SABC to drive its own commercial business model so that it can sustain itself.
- Have an overall percentage of breaks but allow for channel to ascertain the best times to do self-promotion and the best times to sell commercials. Remove the commercial time limitations per slot.
- Remove the separate financial and commercial reporting between PCS and PBS and allow for revenue not be driven across the network per property.

8. Measurement framework and reporting requirements

- The SABC proposes that an outcomes-based approach must be coupled with an appropriate measurement framework to monitor the achievement of outcomes.
- Existing methodologies cover stringently defined areas and this leads to time-consuming calculations which include the Format Factor regime, as well as unnecessarily onerous reporting on mandate performance by the SABC.
- The SABC furthermore proposes that a total overhaul of the licence conditions include an annual reporting focusing on minimum requirements that include number of hours of original first-run South African programming broadcast on its DTT Channels, along with an expectation that the report also covers the digital platforms.
- The Public Broadcaster has reiterated the view that the reporting on mandate obligations are stringent for the public broadcaster, whereas commercial peers operate within an environment that allows for far more self-regulated performance commitments and indicators.

9. Technology neutrality principle

 It is submitted that after Analogue Switch Off (ASO), the practice of issuing separate public service broadcasting licenses must be changed to issuing a single tech-neutral public service broadcasting licence.
