circumvention of ICASA's	
Regulations in respect of	
shareholder changes and	
management control. He	
substantiated the above	
allegation by stating that,	
"the haste in which	
changes to the board of	
NWFM have been made	
irregularly, resulting in	
Motswako taking control of	
the station.	
The CCC did not uphold Mr.	
Setzin's complaint and advanced	
the following reasons that:	
• All resolutions were validly	
All resolutions were validly	
taken by the Directors and	
taken in the interest of the	
survival of the station.	
The relationship with	
Motswako is based on	
contract and where	
Motswako has taken care	
of debts, it was based on	
contract of repayment and	
not as a donation.	
• There is no evidence that
